The Return of the Flag

The 2016 abounded with achievements and successes for RTA. All of these achievements and successes made were thanks to the guidance, care and strong support from His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, UAE Vice President, Prime Minister and Ruler of Dubai. Thus, the Flag returned to where it raised the first time in 2013, when RTA was the first government body to win it for its Metro Express service initiative.

What makes us joyful over this success is that the program carries the name of His Highness Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Crown Prince of Dubai, Chairman of the Executive Council. We also were able to enhance the trust of customers in our services in the most important awards program, which is the vote of the public category.

RTA succeeded for the third year in a row to get the lion's share of Hamdan bin Mohammad Program Awards for Smart Government. It took over 36% of the Program awards since its launch. It won 24 awards out of the total 66 awards won by 34 government entities during the four editions of the Program. RTA culminated its excellnce with winning the Flag twice.

RTA won the program award in its 2016 edition for the best partnership with the public on the initiative Smart Tariff, within the nol card services. It also won the award of the best partnership with the private sector on the initiative 'Smart Bus Shelters,' which provides for bus passengers free internet connection, bill payment, different banking and trading, and a small shop fulfilling some quick needs. RTA also won an award of the best government services via mobile phone for its 'RTA Dubai smart app.' In addition, it won an award of the 'Client Life' category (a joint smart app) for its 'Corporate Business' smart app and it won an award of the best call center for its 8009090 call center. On the individual level, RTA claimed an award of the best innovation team and the best innovation leader and the winner was Dr. Yousef Mohammed Al Ali, CEO of Dubai Taxi Corporation.

The RTA has established a permanent council named 'Youth Council,' that comprises an elite panel of young Emiratis to identify the key opportunities and challenges that face youth at the RTA, shape their future, and compile the necessary programs to qualify and ensure the optimal utilization of youth. I will also draw up plans that contribute to attracting skilled nationals, and encouraging them to innovate and upgrade their administrative and leadership skills." he elaborated.

The Emiratization of senior leadership positions at the RTA has topped 96% and Emiratization of middle leadership positions hovers around 83%. Emirati youth aged 20–30 years account for 75% of total Emiratis employed by the RTA; an indicator that youth are entrusted with leading the RTA future drive. The RTA will continue investing in human resources and nurturing an environment capable of empowering & inspiring youth to make use of their innovative intellects and realize the Dubai Vision 2021. It includes transforming community members into productive, innovative and pioneering individuals who pride themselves on their local culture driven by deep happiness values and forming a key pillar of the Dubai development in various fields.

DTC initiatives plan covers improvement of cabdrivers' attitude

It comprises 86 initiatives to be rolled out through 2021

HE Mattar Al Tayer, Director General and Chairman of the Board of Executive Directors of Roads and Transport Authority (RTA), has approved a plan for improving services of the Dubai Taxi Corporation (DTC) comprising 64 initiatives to be undertaken up to 2021. He also sanctioned a plan for improving attitudes of cabdrivers of DTC encompassing 22 initiatives to be implemented up to 2019.



Al Tayer reiterated RTA's commitment to upgrading the taxi service in Dubai Emirate provided through DTC or franchise companies. He also stressed the importance of utilizing the latest technologies in delivering taxi service via multiple channels highlighted by smart means for the sake of availing added happiness to clients. He also called for beefing-up the taxi & limo fleet to catch up with the rapid growth seen by Dubai in various business, service, financial, property and tourist sectors among others.

Al Tayer made this statement during a visit to the premises of Dubai Taxi Corporation where he met with directors & managers of the DTC in the presence of Mohammed Obaid Al Mulla, Member of RTA's Board of Executive Directors cum Chair of DTC Council and Dr. Yousef Al Ali, CEO of Dubai Taxi Corporation.

"The projects improvement plan of DTC services span five key aspects. The first is the introduction of smart &

innovative transport solution systems. It covers rolling out a trial run of autonomous vehicles along with the operation of smart taxicabs capable of communicating with surrounding vehicles, providing the infrastructure of transport systems such as light signals, and embarking on trial runs of electric/gas-powered vehicles.

"The second aspect relates to upgrading the infrastructure to accommodate the operation needs. This requires the construction of a brand new & integrated depot for taxis in Jebel Ali, upgrading the command & control center, rejuvenating the booking & dispatch center, adding more taxi ranks across Dubai, and expanding maintenance workshops including additional service bays.

"The third aspect is related to the diversification of sources of revenues & profits through alliances with transport companies, ads on school transport buses, and transit services for employees & senior staffs of companies. The



fourth aspect focusses on drivers & employees happiness services involving augmenting the worth of rewards & incentives for drivers. The fifth aspect is concerned with promoting the brand of DTC through offering new services such as the towing of vehicles, ladies limo, tourist limo and cargo taxi," explained Al Tayer.

"The plan for improving the conduct of DTC cabdrivers contains 22 initiatives covering five aspects. The first is technology, which covers upgrading the technological systems of the customers' happiness center, fitting taxicabs with surveillance cameras & interactive screens, implementing DTC customers' relation management system, and the running of taxi on-road performance monitoring system.

"The second aspect relates to legislations. It encompasses a host of initiatives such as the improvement of quality offences code, procedures for spotting offending drivers, improvement of rewards & incentives system, and the revision of conditions for the rotation of drivers over a variety of occupations. The third aspect relates to operations and covers the improvement of HR procedures, and the assessment of workload on drivers by adding two hours to the weekly rest and offering a weekly holiday to cabbies. It also includes upgrading drivers' recruitment processes guided by conduct complaint results where the emphasis will be placed on training on using different & creative techniques. It also includes recruiting drivers from new nationalities, and upgrading drivers' educative programs with an emphasis on the etiquette of dealing with customers, and revamped procedures for investigating complaints & conduct offences on the part of drivers. The fourth aspect focuses on performance through following up performance reports, reviewing & analyzing targets, developing cracking solutions on feedbacks and enhancing departmental improvement plans. The fifth aspect focuses on measurement. It measures the impact of implementing improvement initiatives & projects, the efficiency of technological systems & usage ratios, and checking the extent of compliance with the implementation of legislations as well as the effectiveness of operations executed," added Al Tayer.

It is noteworthy that the RTA has recently adopted a plan for beefing up DTC taxi fleet by more than 38%. Accordingly, the number of vehicles is set to rise from 5046 cabs in 2016 to as many as 7000 cabs by 2020. The number of limos is expected to see a sharp increase by a whopping 240% from 146 vehicles in 2016 to 500 vehicles in 2020. The upsurge in the number of taxicabs is intended to satisfy the projected steady increase in customers demand, be it from residents or visitors, and serve the needs of Dubai hosting Expo 2020.

The plan envisages transforming 50% of taxicabs into hybrid cabs by 2021 as part of a plan to curb carbon emissions from the taxi sector by 2% in compliance with the needs of the Dubai Supreme Council of Energy and the Green Economy drive. Accordingly, the number of hybrid vehicles of DTC is set to leapfrog from 145 vehicles in 2015 to 2280 vehicles by 2021. This massive increase is being contemplated because of deregulating fuel prices and the low lifecycle cost of hybrid vehicles compared with conventional vehicles.

10 Cosmopolitan cities participate in 1st Urban Mobility Innovation Index Forum

"The Urban Mobility Innovation Index launched by His Highness Sheikh Hamdan bin Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Crown Prince of Dubai and Chairman of the Executive Council, is the first of its kind worldwide. It aims at attracting countries with advanced knowledge in this discipline to offer the best innovative global practices in mobility," said Al Tayer.

"The Index, which focuses on three themes: "Readiness,

Implementation and Quality of Life, focuses on holding benchmarks with the authorities concerned at transport sector worldwide, identifying areas of innovation, conducting internal as well as specialized workshops presented by urban transport professionals. Phase I of the Index was implemented in five cities, namely London, Helsinki, Singapore Sao Paulo, and Dubai. The Index principally aims to foster cooperation among cities, conduct innovation benchmarking in mobility, and provide information network about advanced cities in innovative mobility. It is also intended to classify and compare various mobility innovation pillars measured by innovation in the Urban Mobility Innovation Index, in order to embark on self-improvement through engaging in practices, sharing expertise and using common codes & indicators."

17% of Dubai Budget2017 goes to infrastructure projects

Dubai Govt. continues upgrading infrastructure to cement its leading model

HE Mattar Al Tayer, Director-General and Chairman of the Board of Executive Directors of Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) said that the General Budget of the Dubai Government endorsed by His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President, Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai had confirmed that Dubai is well on track in undertaking infrastructure development projects;



Al Tayer was pleased with the confirmation from of 20 cities to participate in the Urban Mobility Innovation Index. The list includes Amman, Amsterdam, Kuala Lumpur, Montréal, Munich, Warsaw New York, Sydney, Tokyo and Nairobi. The overall objective is to involve 30 cities in the inaugural edition of the Forum.

"Data will soon be collected, processed & analyzed, and the relevant reports will be prepared. The results of the first cycle of the Urban Mobility Innovation Index will be released at the UITP Congress in Montreal in May next year, and the Index will be implemented periodically through the UITP," said Al Tayer.

During the Forum, the Urban Mobility Innovation Index

Project was reviewed and the Innovation Index website was launched. A panel discussion & brainstorming session took place to discuss the data related to the Index. The participating delegations had a tour around Dubai via the Dubai Tram, Dubai Metro Dubai and public buses.

It is noteworthy that the RTA adopted has recently approved RTA's Innovation Strategy, which is based on three major pillars: Leadership, Excellence and Impact. This Strategy aims to empower the RTA deliver inspiring innovations at the present and future. After all, innovation plays a key role in improving products, services and business process towards generating a sustainable benefit for all community segments.

the key development driver of any city worldwide. About 17% of the total government budget has been allocated to infrastructure projects. 50% of RTA's budget has been allocated to the construction of road & mass transit system projects in a bid to provide a first-class infrastructure that contributes to realizing RTA's vision of Safe & Smooth Transport for All.

"RTA has stepped up the efficiency of its budget by augmenting revenues, which witnessed a healthy 13% growth rate compared with last year's levels, contributing to an operational surplus of about AED4 billion.

"In 2017, RTA will complete the construction of several projects currently underway such as the Airport Improvement Road costing about AED404 million, Umm Al Sheef & Latifa bint Hamdan Street costing AED501 million, and the Ac-

ademic City Street Improvement Project costing AED474 million. Projects also include the intersection of Sheikh Rashid Road with Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed costing about AED611 million, upgrading roads network around Expo 2020 costing about AED3.2 billion, and the Enterprise Command & Control Center (EC3) project to be opened in the first half of 2017. There is also a portfolio of new projects highlighted by Route 2020 project covering the extension of the Red Line of Dubai Metro up to 15 km comprising seven stations. A strategic project is also set for construction to connect Dubai with Hatta through Lehbab in coordination with the Infrastructure Development Ministry at a cost of about AED54 million, in addition to internal road projects several residential communities, especially in Hatta among other projects to be announced early 2017.

Opening Deira Islands Entrance Bridge

In implementation of the directives of HH Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President, Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai, to expedite the construction of infrastructure of roads network leading to Deira Island, the Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) opened the bridge leading to Deira Islands Project costing about AED150 million.

HE Mattar Al Tayer, Director–General and Chairman of the Board of Executive Directors of RTA said: "the project undertaken by RTA in conjunction with Nakheel included the construction of a temporary entrance to Deira Islands and the opening of the Water Canal for navigation. Nakheel has started infrastructure for islands and maritime works by completing the entrance of the western bridge & linking it with Al Khaleej Road in the direction of the new ships harbor and fish market along the stretch of Abu Baker Al Siddique Road starting from the R/A at the intersection with Al Khaleej Road.

The project also included opening the navigational lane beneath the bridge by removing about two million cubic meters of drilling materials in three landfill areas. Works also included extending the existing canal walls up to the new fish market marina in addition to lighting works, sewage, asphalt, shifting & protecting the existing services, and extending services along the bridges. Following the opening of the bridge, the project contractor will remove the last landfill area to complete works for opening the navigational canal.

It is noteworthy that Deira Islands project, developed by Nakheel, is the new waterfront of Dubai. It comprises four man-made islands inside the Arabian Gulf waters along the stretch of Deira Beach spanning an area of about 17 m square meters. The project, which is the biggest develop-

No change in truck movement timing Amendments done in coordination with local

The Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) confirmed that it had attached top priority to traffic safety and land transport in view of its role in supporting the economic, urban and business cycles.

Nasser Hamad Abu Shehab, CEO of Strategy & Corporate Governance Sector, said, "RTA had commissioned a comprehensive study of traffic movement in Dubai covering field surveys, interviews, and workshops involving concerned departments and businesses. Accordingly, the RTA has developed a schematic model for anticipating truck movement in future, explored the need for trains & water transport lines for the transportation of goods, and assessed the need for dry ports or commodity assembly & distribution centers. Studies also examined the existing

trucks prohibited movement timings and the need for providing truck-exclusive roads in addition to organizational & structural matters relating to the movement of trucks and commodities across Dubai.

"Fixing the prohibited truck movement timing on Dubai roads requires full coordination with public and private entities concerned with the movement of goods. RTA is currently undertaking several projects for the construction of ramps linking the Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed Road and Emirates Road, and the construction of 24 truck



ment project in Deira, comprises the construction of hundreds of hotels, hotel apartments, multi-use buildings and marinas. The project is expected to be inhabited by 250 thousand persons and 80 thousand employees.

According to traffic studies, the volume of traffic generated by the project is about 110 thousand journeys during peak hours that requires the construction of a massive

network of roads and transit systems. There will be three main entrances to the project, two at the intersection of Al Khaleej Road with Abu Baker Al Siddique Road and Al Quds Road, and the third extends from Al Mina Road alongside Rashid Port. The project provides for direct and free entrances through flyovers leading to all entrances of the project.

rest areas on the Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed Road and Emirates Road. Accordingly, RTA would fix the prohibited truck movement timing in Dubai, especially in the Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed Road and Emirates Road, two highways linking Dubai with other Emirates. RTA had earlier widened these two corridors to six lanes in each direction to accommodate the huge growth in land transport movement and keep pace with the urbanization rate seen by Dubai Emirate, especially as these corridors directly serve industrial and logistical areas in the Emirate," explained Abu Shehab.

The traffic movement on the Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed Road and Emirates Road will remain as it is in the

Emirate of Dubai. In coordination with the General HQ of Dubai Police, and Dubai Ports Authority, the RTA will set controls governing the movement of traffic on the Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed Road and Emirates Road to ensure aligning it with the traffic movement in Dubai Ports. Every attention will be given to avoid disrupting the movement of goods from and to Dubai Ports, or impacting the role of Dubai as a premier regional shipping & distribution hub. RTA will engage with the concerned federal entities, such as the Ministry of Interior & the Ministry of Infrastructure Development, to coordinate measures safeguarding the interests of stakeholders in the public & private sectors.



In a couple of years, RTA would design and construct roads in Makan residential area and Crushers area in Hatta at an estimated cost of AED 15 million. RTA would continue upgrading roads infrastructure and services in the area as part of Hatta future development plans," continued Al Tayer.

Al Tayer reiterated RTA's keenness to upgrade the road

network to keep pace with the demographic and urban growth, expand roads capacity to accommodate the increasing number of vehicles, and ease the traffic movement in Hatta in implementation of the master plan sanctioned by His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum.


More services to Al Barsha Center to enhance customers' happiness

Ridership of Inter-City buses from Sharjah to Dubai on the rise

The inter-city bus service shuttling between Dubai and Sharjah has reported a rise in the number of commuters by 6.4% during the period from Jan 1 to Nov 30 this year compared with statistics recorded during the same period last year. The improved ridership figures attribute to the improvements made by Public Transport Agency, Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) to bus stops in Sharjah.

"The improvements made revolve around the increased number of bus stops in areas on the route of buses traveling in Sharjah on the way to Dubai, enabling commuters residing in Sharjah travel to their various destinations in Dubai," said Basel Ibrahim Saad, Director of Buses, RTA's Public Transport Agency.

"The bus routes that had seen increased stops are E303, E303A, E304, E306, E307, and E307A. These routes are located along Al Wahda Road and King Faisal Road. Commuters lifted from Sharjah on these routes during the period from Jan 1 to Nov 30 this year amounted to 2,867,996 riders; compared with 2,694,834 riders during the same period last year," revealed Saad.

"These improvements in the inter-city bus network op-

erating between Dubai and Sharjah had been undertaken in a bid to ease the picking-up of commuters residing in areas nearby the routes of these buses on their way to Dubai, thus obviating them the need to go to the main station at Al Jubail, Sharjah. The increase in the bus stops of inter-city service in Sharjah has three objectives; bring happiness to commuters, eliminate the thronging of Al Jubail Station, and augment the revenues of RTA by curbing illegal passenger transport activities from King Faisal and Al Ittihad Roads in Sharjah," he added.

"The first pick-up point on King Faisal Road is near Jumbo Sony Station, and then the service stops opposite to City Center Sharjah, nearby the subway. The last two bus stops are one opposite to Safeer Mall and the other is oppo-

Solar-powered abra can travel 6 hours

The Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) has recently announced the formal operation of a solar-powered abra, considered the first of its kind in the Middle East. The introduction of this sophisticated abra, which is being deployed at Al Mamzar, follows several trial runs to verify the possibility of changing speed. The scheme is part of Dubai Government's initiative billed: Green Economy for a Sustainable Environment.

Abdullah Yousef Al Ali, CEO of RTA Public Transport Agency, said, "This abra is the first public marine transit mode powered by solar energy in the Middle East. The project was intended to convert an abra powered by electricity into an abra powered by solar energy through fitting the roof of the abra with solar panels along with other op-

erational accessories.

"A specialist company has conducted a Balance Test during a one-month trial run of the abra at Al Jaddaf with no riders onboard. It was established that the solar power system would have no negative impact on the stability and balance of the hull of the abra, and accordingly, there

would be no need for tinkering with the design or specifications of the existing abra or even building new ones. Results have shown that the solar system can charge the battery up to 100% every day, the stored power would be good enough to drive the abra for five hours at the normal operating speed of 3–4 knots, and the residual power in the battery would be around 25%. The system requires about six daytime hours to recharge the battery in full," explained Al Ali.

"The launch of this abra is part of RTA strategy towards fully adopting the Green Economy concept and using clean energy in various public transit means. The RTA is focused on turning these concepts into reality through creative initiatives for curbing carbon footprint, and using alternative energy in mass transit means," added the CEO of RTA Public Transport Agency.



Increasing entry gates at Business Bay Metro Station

RTA's Rail Agency has added six fare collection gates to the Business Bay Metro Station, thus raising the number of entry gates at the station from 4 to 10. The step has been taken in response to the growing footfall at the station, which is in line with the sustained growth in demand for the metro service in Dubai fueled by ever-increasing demographic & urbanization rates in the Emirate. The move comes at a time where mass transit means in general and Dubai Metro, in particular, is heading towards an exceptional demand from visitors & tourists especially on the eve of the New Year 2017.

In the four-digit plates, the number I 1000 was sold for AED1.1 million. In the five-digit plates, the number L 11111-yielded AED1.98 million and E 55555 was sold for AED1.03 million.

"A lucky bidder was awarded the complimentary plate P 479 through a draw conducted at the end of the auction in a bid to add happiness to clients and encourage them to attend the forthcoming auctions.

"The 93rd plate was hugely competitive attracting bidders from all spectrums of the community with different age levels and backgrounds in a testament to the success of public auctions; which have now reached 93 sessions. The next open auction will be held in February 2017," added Bahrozyan.

Around 1.8 m PT riders on New Year's Eve

The number of riders lifted on board public transit means of the Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) on the eve of the New Year 2017 has clocked 1,793,691 riders, according to statistics released by RTA.
