Tyre Safety Campaign launched for cars and trucks

The Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) has organised a one-week campaign to check tyre safety in light and heavy vehicles in its Customer Happiness centre in Al-Barsha, and Vegetable and Fruit Market. The campaign was organised in cooperation with Dubai Municipality's Assets Management Department, Emirates National Oil Company (ENOC), and Michelin Tyres. The campaign included tests for tyres to reveal any kind of defect, and advice on early detection of wear and tear. The campaign also urged drivers not to neglect changing tires before they wear out, especially in summer's high temperatures, as they could burst while driving and lead to serious accidents. Awareness messages been broadcasted also on some Arabic and English speaking radios.Campaign organisers also offered drivers presents and AED300-discount on their next change of tyres, in addition to meals and juices presented by the KAF Group.


Teaching with fun at Kids Venture
