#### **Distance lectures** for students and drivers

Awareness activities for targeted groups continued in Dubai through the "Distance Awareness" program that was introduced by the Traffic Awareness Section after applying the precautionary measures to confront Covid19-.

The Section has organized several awareness lectures during the past weeks, targeting students at Dubai schools, and employees of some transportation companies operating in Dubai. Many students and parents at Dubai National School and its two branches in Al Barsha and Al Twar through "Microsoft teams" have listened to awareness tips from the awareness booklet "Parents' Guide to Child Safety ", in addition to reviewing the precautionary measures followed by the Dubai Roads and Transport Authority to maintain the safety of metro users.

Plan your journey on the metro in advance, avoid peak hours and be sure to follow the instructions of the station supervisors

Make sure there is an empty seat next to you and follow the alternate seating policy

Keep a safe distance of 2m between you and others while waiting for the metro

> Don't crowd around the metro entrance and wait for the next trip if the cabin is full

#### **Paper Recycling**

Matthias Koops extracted the ink from paper and converted the paper into a pulp from which new papers were made for writing and printing and his method was then used in all the paper mills at that time

> How did the recycling process start?

Then people moved to use trees and wood fibers to make paper, then Matthias Koops established the first paper mill in England in 1801

Impressive!

There are acceptable types such as newspapers, magazines, brochures, white paper, wallpaper and decoration and all similar things Are all types of paper recyclable?

What about unacceptable types? Unacceptable types include paper stained with food, paint, or dirt in general and hygiene products such as napkins and nappies, sticky paper or duct tape, gift wrappers and candy wrappers

What are the stages of recycling?

The stages of paper recycling are 7, first is Collecting; Collecting the used aper from institutions, schools, and authorities



Secondly sorting; It is considered the most important stage in recycling paper, in order to get a good quality paper, it requires good sorting After that, the floating stage where the cut paper is immersed in water tanks shredding stage comes with the cutting machine

After that, the paper-cut mixing stage is used by a mixing device to get the dough

Then the formation stage in which the paper is formed in different ways, according

to the required product... The last stage is drying the formed paper
