

Top Scoop

Traffic Department's activities reaches thousands of workers in Dubai

The Traffic Department has developed an innovative digital tool in cooperation with major contractors in Dubai to deliver traffic awareness messages and content to thousands of workers in a direct and fast manner. The department also provided tens of companies with educational traffic material, including a video on safety

procedures for workers.

Activities on traffic awareness were held over the past few weeks in work areas and training facilities of several large companies. They included audio-visual presentations on safety precautions that workers need to follow to avoid traffic accidents and the risk of being hit by a vehicle.





"Committed to the safety procedures"



The Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) has taken part in the traffic awareness campaign targeting cyclists that was organised over a period of four days by Dubai Police General Command in several areas of the emirate.

The campaign was launched at the Nad Al-Sheba cycling track with attendance of a big audience participation and a large number of professional and amateur cyclists who received helmets and educational material on cycling safety from the campaign organisers in several locations, including Nad Al-Sheba racecourse, Al-Khawaneej racecourse and Al-Qudra, over the four days of the campaign.



Online awareness workshops targets Dubai and Ras Al-Khaimah schools

Online traffic workshops were organised using distance learning methods for students at Ghalila School in Ras Al-Khaimah and Ahmed Bin Rashid School in Dubai.

Provided through the Zoom application, the interactive workshops focused on traffic safety, especially instructions for commuters to safely use roads and avoid traffic accidents and injuries.

The Traffic Awareness section at the Traffic Department has participated in the Students Enrichment Summer Programme organised by the Ministry of Education. Dozens of students benefitted from the online awareness workshop and lecture organised by the Traffic Awareness team over the Microsoft Team application.

The lecture introduced students to road safety measures that they should comply with to avoid traffic accidents.


