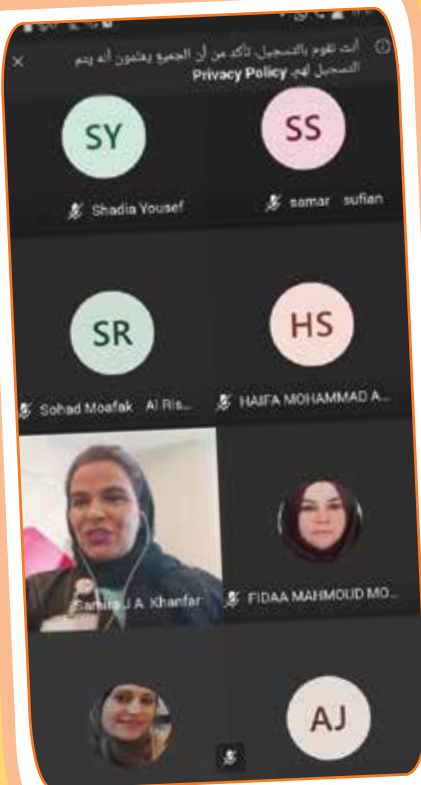
Innovation Lab's "Cycling is a Lifestyle"

The discussion focused on infrastructure, engineering aspects, legal systems, and awareness channels that can provide a safe and comfortable environment for cyclists in Dubai.



Virtual workshop on school bus safety

The Traffic Department has organised a virtual workshop over the "Teams" application titled "Our children's safety on the school bus". The interactive workshop, which saw participation from Dubai National Charity School teachers, discussed traffic signs and their meaning, and student's behaviour inside the school bus.



The Traffic Department and Infiniti donate child's car seats to mothers

The Traffic Department in cooperation with Infiniti Dubai cars' company has donated child's car seats to new mothers at Latifa Hospital, Al Zahraa Hospital and International Modern Hospital. The move was part of a campaign organised with the private sector to encourage mothers to use child's seats in their vehicles. The department also held educational activities for nurses in the Al Zahraa Hospital's obstetrics ward in Dubai, where an expert in child's traffic safety gave a lecture explaining in detail the use and importance of child's seats. The nurses were encouraged to pass this knowledge to expecting mothers in the obstetrics ward and guide them on how to choose a suitable child's seat.

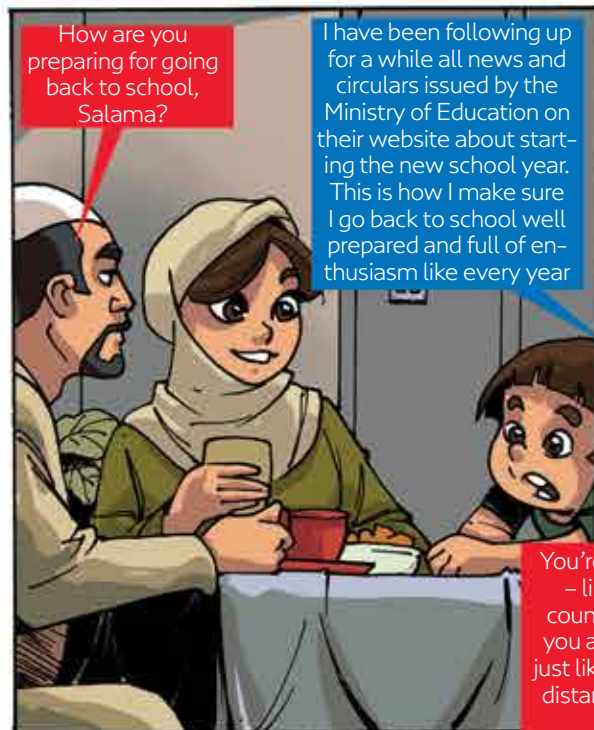


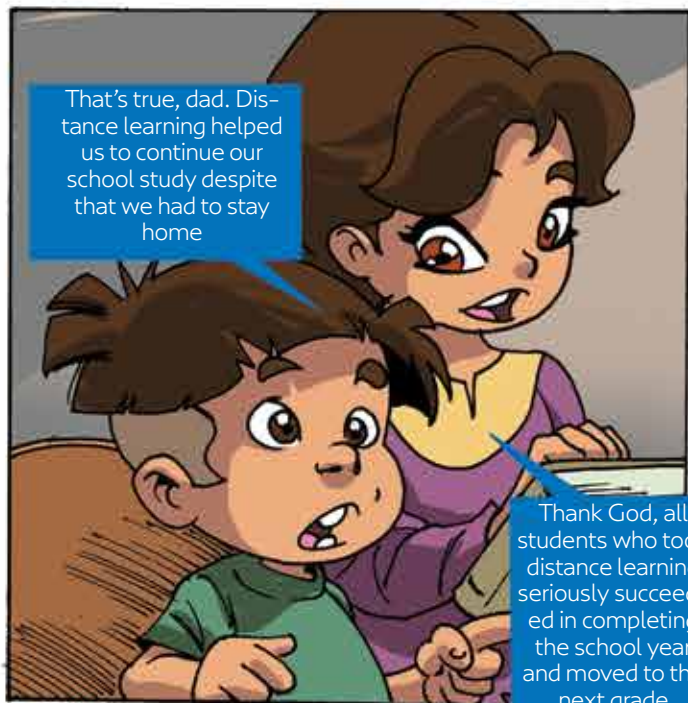

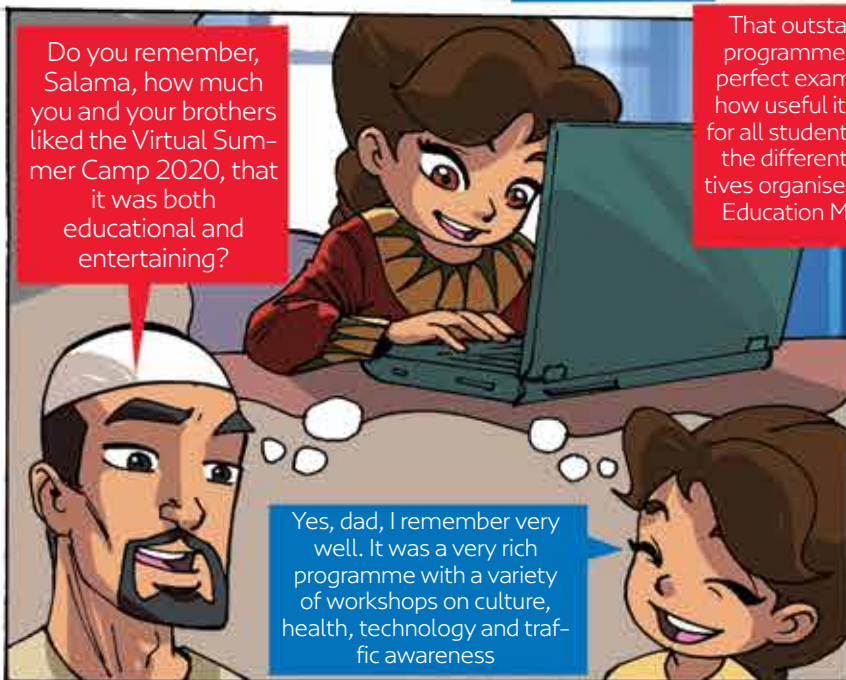
That's true, dad. Distance learning helped us to continue our school study despite that we had to stay home

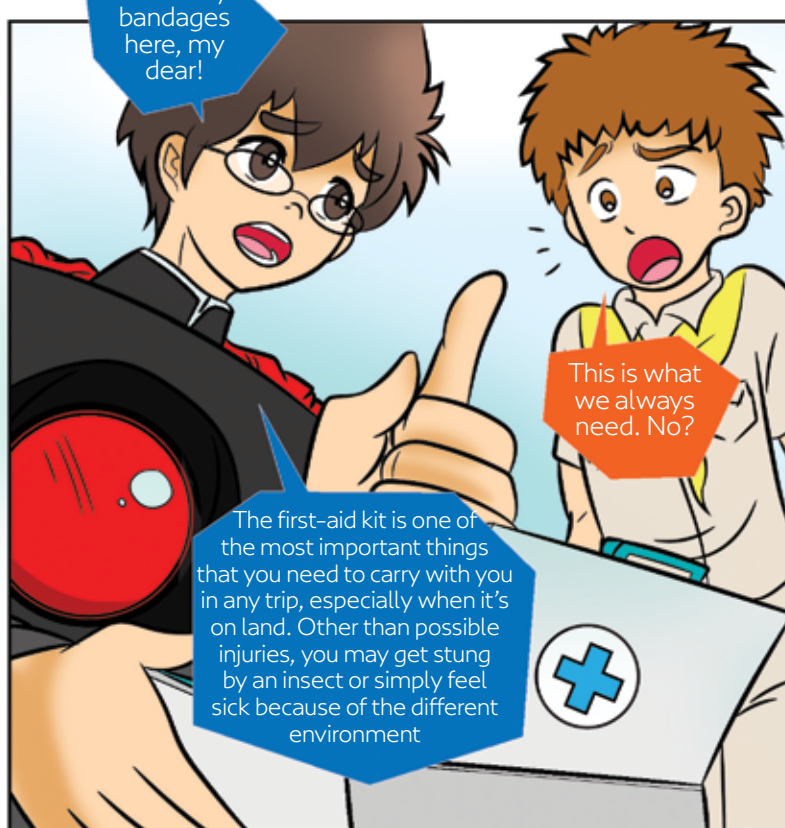
Are you all ready? Today, we are going for a walk in an area that has some wild animals. So, I want each one of you to carry a first-aid kit

I'm sorry, champ! I did not pay attention, as usual

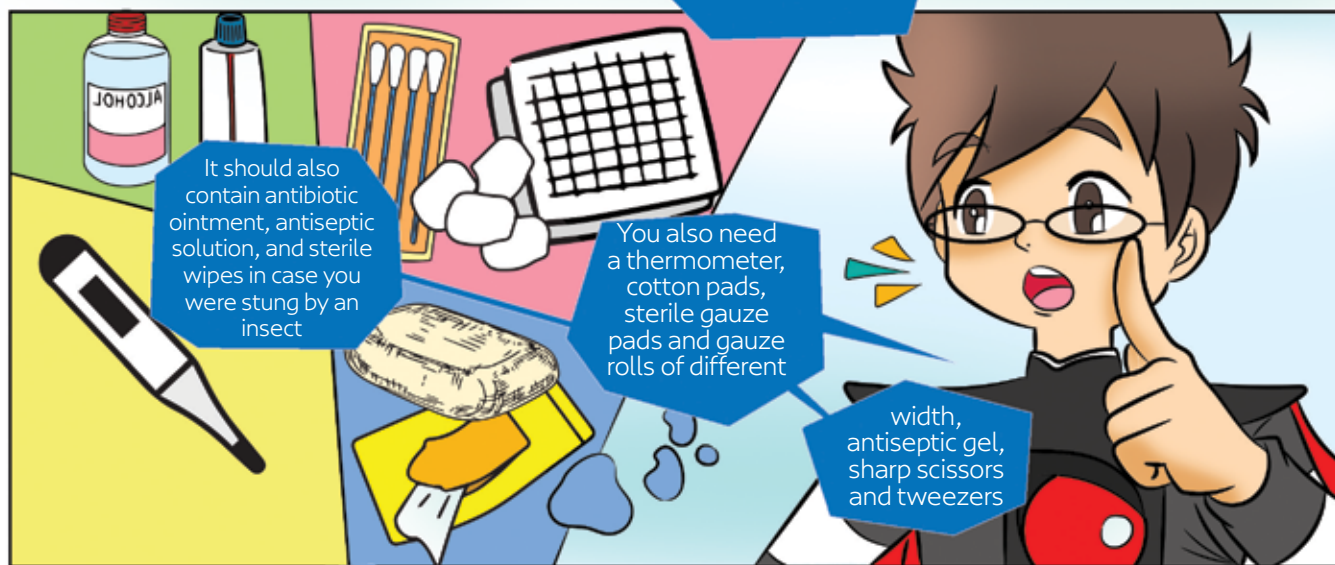
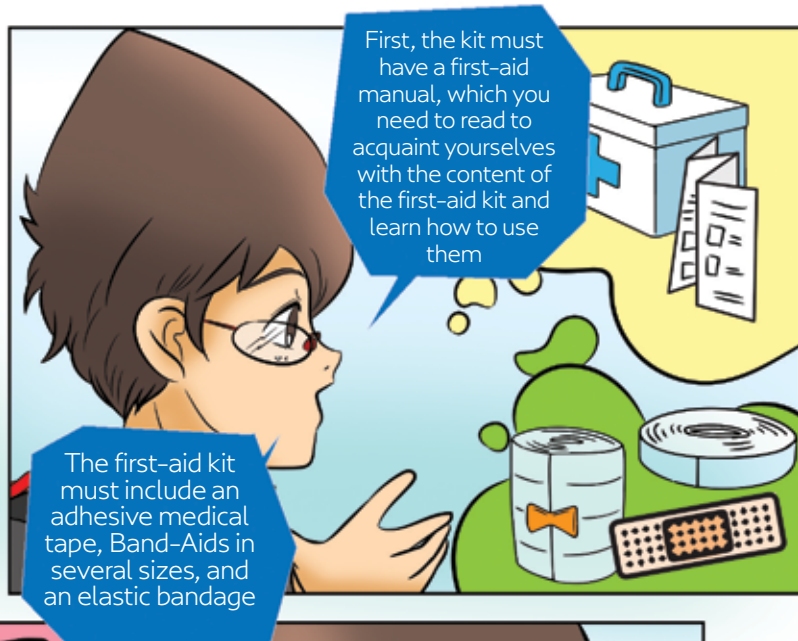
I have my kit with me... Look!

I had a terrible nightmare about me having the virus

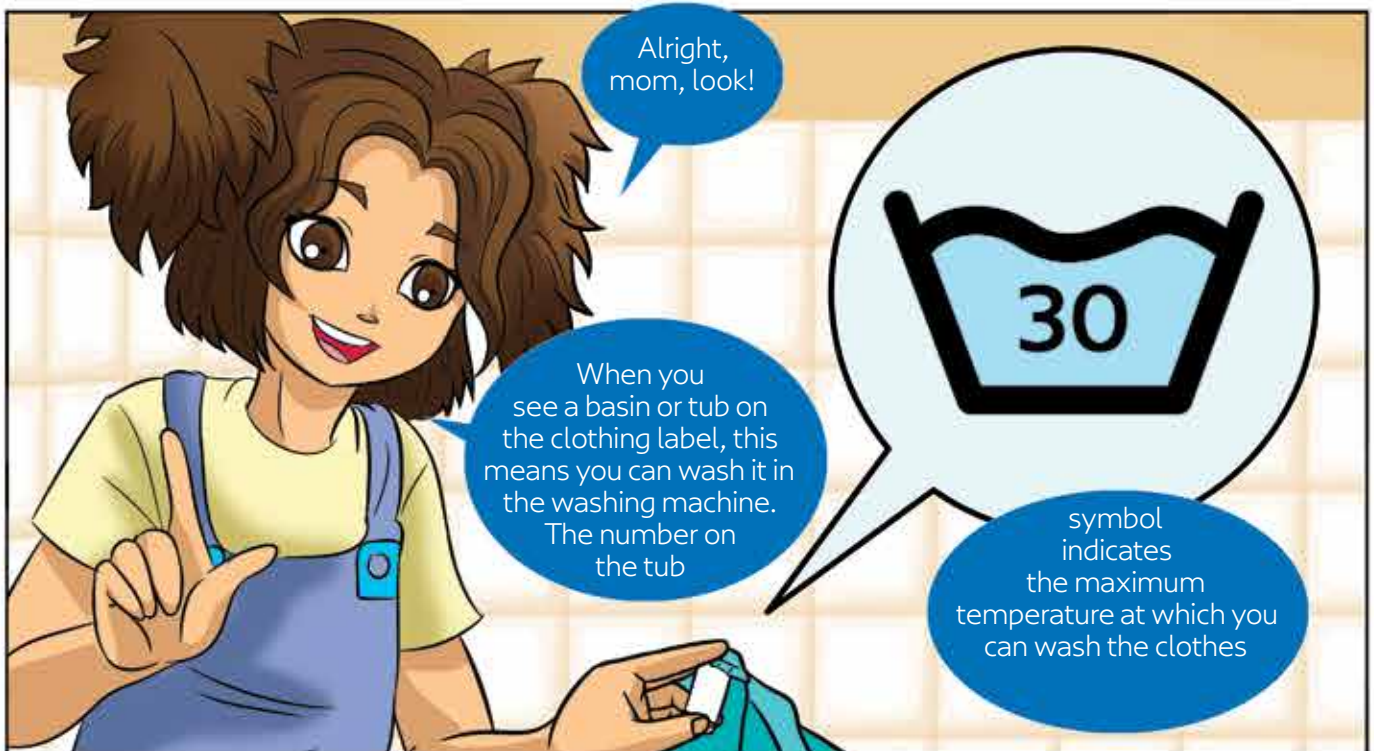
Alright! I hope this nightmare doesn't turn into reality – especially with you being so stubborn about ignoring safety precautions

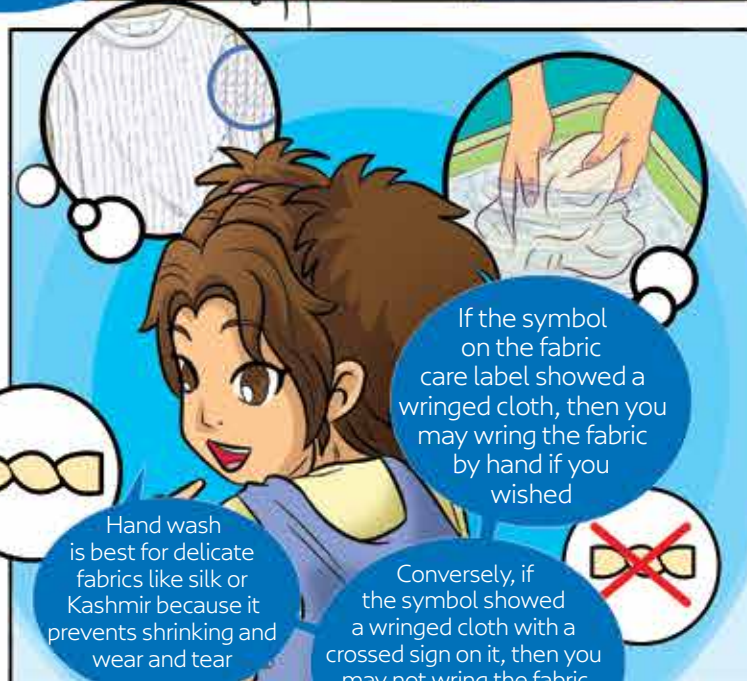
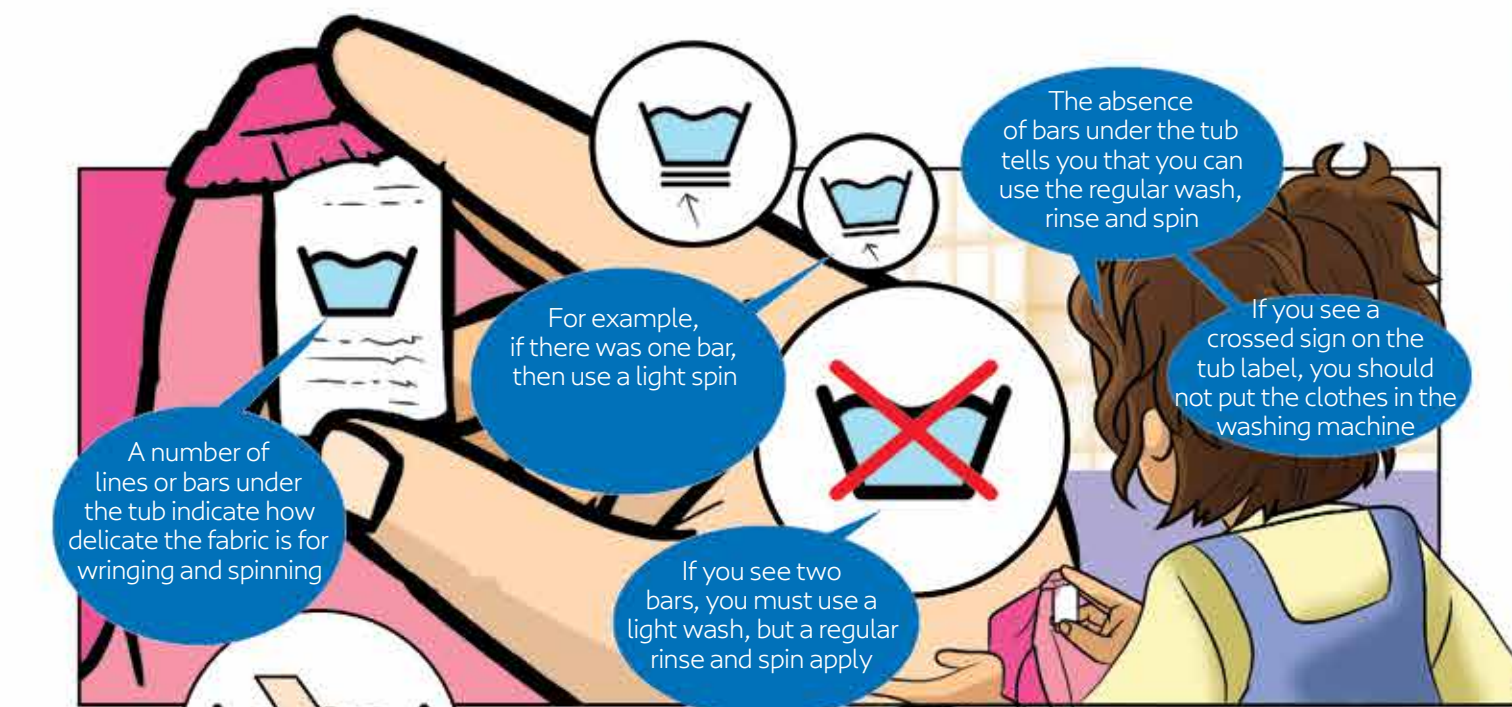

The Baby Chef

Crunchy Cauliflower

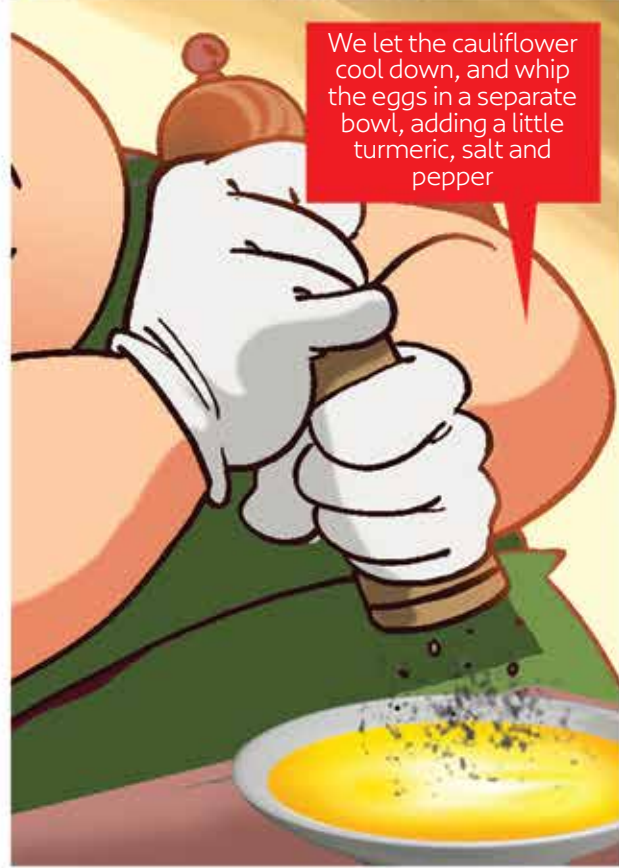
Hello, my friends. As you can see, our dish for today is crunchy cauliflower. To prepare it, we need one cauliflower, 3 eggs, breadcrumbs, turmeric, oil, salt and pepper



We start by cutting and boiling the cauliflower in water for no more than 15 minutes, adding some salt



We let the cauliflower cool down, and whip the eggs in a separate bowl, adding a little turmeric, salt and pepper



Finally, we dip the cauliflower pieces in the whipped eggs, then dip it in the breadcrumb and fry them



The tasty crunchy cauliflower is now ready. Enjoy!
