

Awareness campaign for truck drivers

Last November, an awareness campaign targeting truck drivers has been launched in cooperation with Dubai Police. The campaign aimed to enhance drivers' awareness of the most serious violations that could lead to traffic accidents, in addition to the dangers of stopping on the hard shoulder of the road, and the importance of adhering to parking in designated places or rest stops. The campaign targeted truck assembly points; such as the vegetable and fruit market in Dubai, and rest stops.





A movie for bikers

The Traffic Safety Section released an awareness film for cyclists based on animation technology, to promote bikers' awareness of traffic safety guidelines, such as adhering to bike lanes, wearing a helmet, and properly using hand signals when stopping or turning left or right.

Awarenessraising workshops for private companies staff

The Traffic Safety Section has organized several awareness workshops for private companies staff, highlighting the importance of safe driving and the most prominent violations that could lead to traffic accidents. The workshops, which were held in coordination with private companies, also stressed the need to cross roads from designated places only, and not to risk crossing highways, as this may lead to deadly accidents.

The coordination between the Traffic Department and schools in Dubai has resulted in several awareness messages being sent to students on social media, WhatsApp and Telegram groups. Texted in November, the messages focused on how to properly and safely cross roads, while doing it from designated places only.

The department also organized some awareness lectures as part of a remote awareness program to boost students' knowledge on how to safely use bicycles in addition to the safety measures that must be taken into account when cycling.

Senior citizens and Public parking

It is a new parking meter and it works very well ...
Look, you have to put in the money here May I ask you how old you are and whether this vehicle is yours?

I am 63 years old and this is my vehicle

I have good news for you, the Roads and Transport Authority in Dubai has exempted senior citizens who are over 60 from paying parking fees in the Emirate of Dubai, but under certain conditions.

Vehicles must comply with the Traffic Law and refrain from using designated parking lots for certain categories such as people of determination, those reserved in advance by some institutions or owners in residential areas. Using parking spaces designated for public transport vehicles is also not allowed.

through the authority's website,


Definitely No! This permit can only be used by senior citizens, and in case of being misused, it will be cancelled and legal measures will be taken by the RTA.
