### Hope Probe to Mars

#### Hello Dear friends..

The UAE Hope Probe has successfully made it to Mars after a 7-month journey, during which it travelled 494 million km, making the UAE the first Arab nation, and the fifth in the world, to reach the red planet.

The probe's arrival at Mars orbit would allow for sending new data about the atmosphere of the red planet. It will remain in Mars orbit for two earth years, or a "Martian year", during which it will study everything related to the weather of the Mars, with the help of three advanced scientific instruments; including an infrared spectrometer, UV Spectrophotometer, and a high-resolution

digital exploration camera to discover the atmospheric pressure and climate there.

Our warmest congratulations to the UAE and Arab people for such a breakthrough, which coincides with the UAE's golden jubilee and achieves Zayed's dream. We all hope that we will embark on the next fifty with greater goals for the Arabs and humanity because we are people who knows nothing impossible.








Well done son! I am so proud of you!







The next day, Abdullah called out the neighbours' children to see the two new birds. When they met, he suggested something to them.






Nader took the bird from Abdullah's hand and put it back in the cage.

Thank God, I arrived on time to prevent a disaster


A disaster!

Sorry, I did not know it is risky, but what is the right way to bathe birds?






## Crossing the road safely

## Bicycle Safe Driving - Part 1
