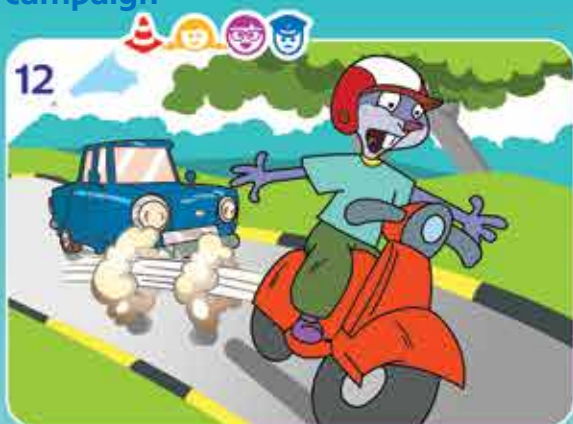

# Top Scoop

## “Give way in the fast lane” Safety campaign



The Dubai Police and Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) have jointly launched “Give way in the fast lane” awareness campaign in mid-March, to enhance drivers’ awareness of the need to clear the fast lane on roads, and not to use it except for overtaking vehicles, and then return to the right lane while maintaining enough and safe distance of other vehicles.

Both entities promoted the campaign which was launched by the Director-General, Chairman of the Board of Executive Directors of the RTA and Commander-in-Chief of Dubai Police, in the media, social media platforms and billboards in streets and malls.

### Enjoy your Iftar.... and focus on your way

The Traffic Department has launched an awareness campaign targeting drivers during Ramadan entitled “Enjoy your Iftar... and focus on your way”, in cooperation with many driving centres and private companies. Four institutes took part in the campaign, including Emirates Driving Institute, Dubai Driving Center, Emirates Transport Driving Institute and Bin Yaber Driving Institute. The campaign saw the distribution of more than 4000 coupons (Iftar meals) featuring safe driving instructions printed on them.

Dubai Investment and Michelin Group sponsored Iftar meals for 2,000 taxi drivers that were distributed to their places of residence, along with awareness leaflets about safe driving during Ramadan.





## Awareness campaign to urge drivers to respect pedestrians' right to cross

The RTA has collaborated with Dubai Police to implement a large-scale awareness campaign aimed at enhancing drivers' awareness of the dangers and penalties of not respecting the right of pedestrians to cross.

The campaign saw the two entities sharing awareness messages on social media and billboards in streets, Dubai Metro, customer service centres and local radio stations, in addition to cooperating with the Public Parking Department to distribute an awareness leaflet entitled "Making the way for pedestrians" that included a set of awareness-raising instructions, highlighting the need to respect pedestrians' right to cross, and traffic laws. Medical masks were also attached to leaflet when distributed to drivers in parking lots.



## Awareness activities for Dulsco drivers

More than 60 drivers from Dulsco attended awareness activities organized by the Traffic Department at the company's headquarters on the safety rules when driving a vehicle, and the need to respecting the right of pedestrians to cross. The activities also highlighted the violations and fines resulting thereof. It was agreed with those involved in the company's management to publish flashes and awareness films on the company's electronic screens so that the informational messages reach the largest possible number of drivers, employees and customers.

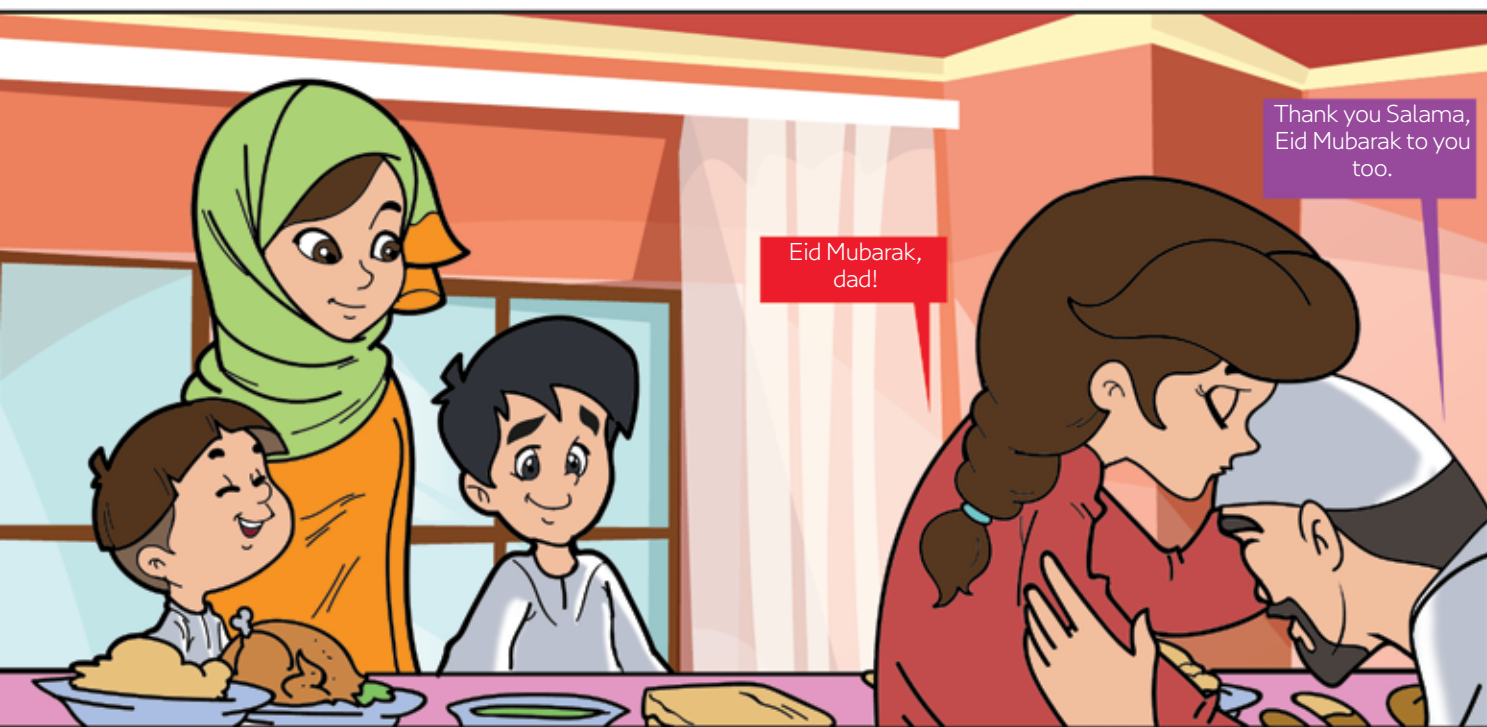




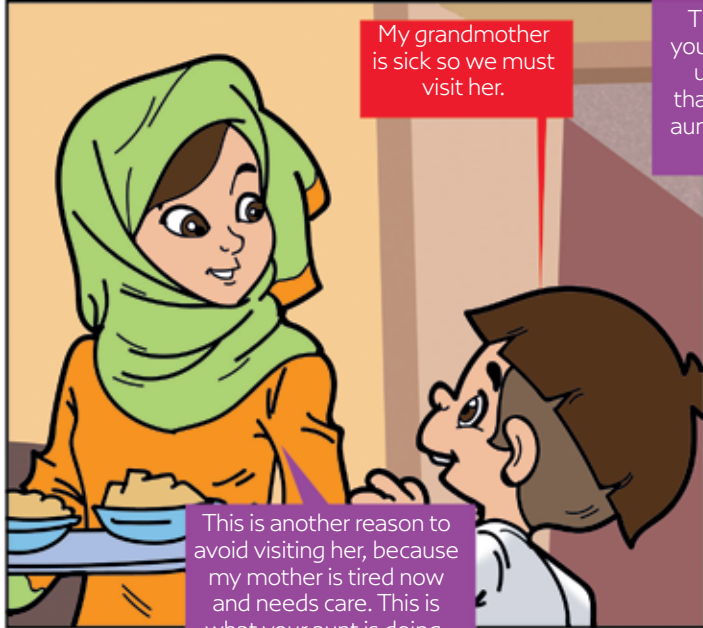

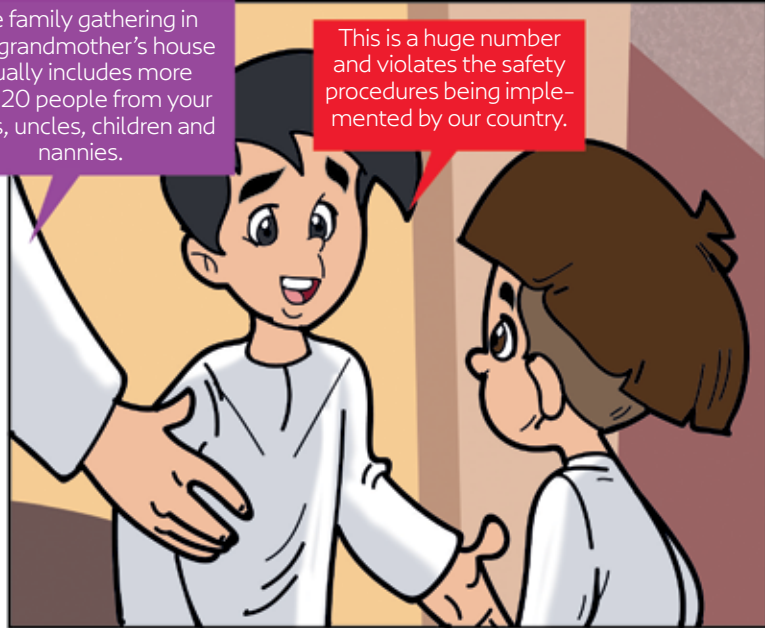




My grandmother is sick so we must visit her.

This is a huge number and violates the safety procedures being implemented by our country.



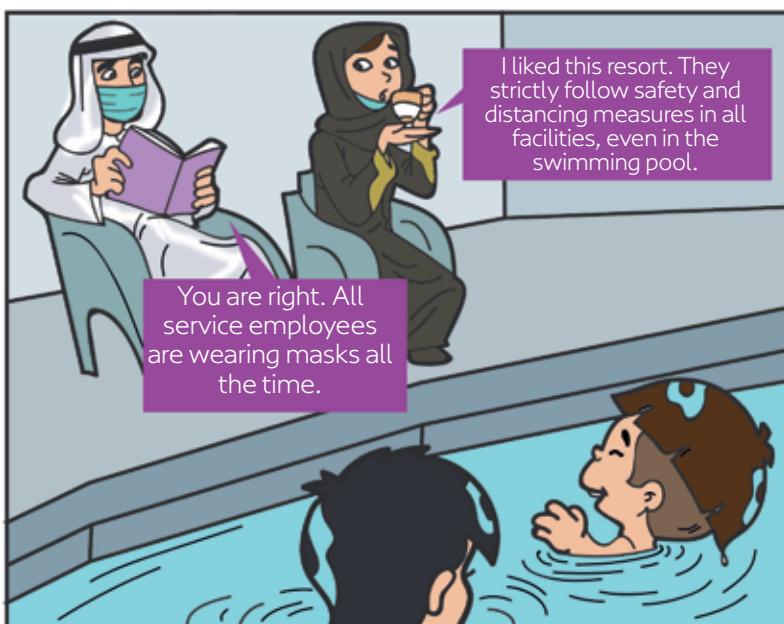
So how do I feel the joy of Eid ?!

I am happy for you, son, take care!

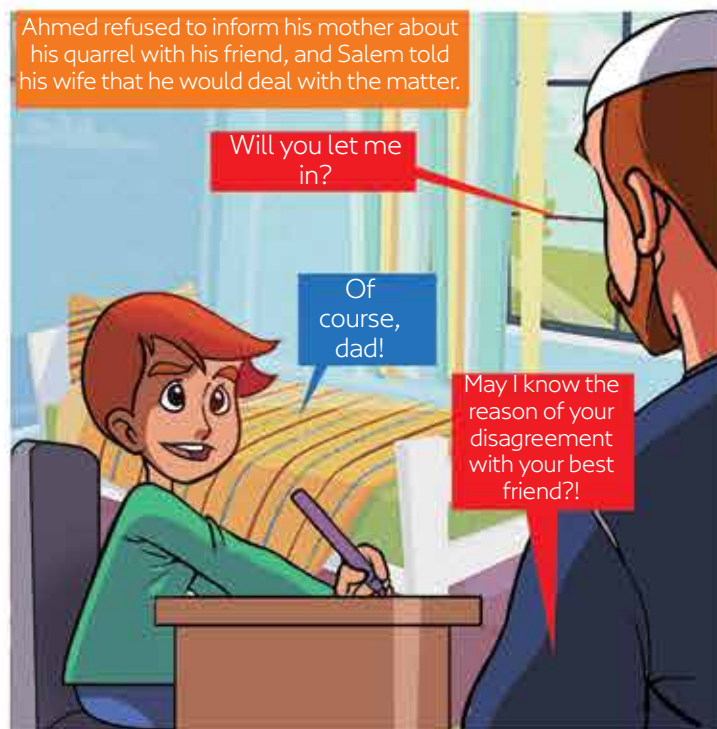

The carpenter who works at Salem's house left his tools and went to get some things. Salem saw the carpenter leaving and called his brothers and neighbors' children while thinking of something ...





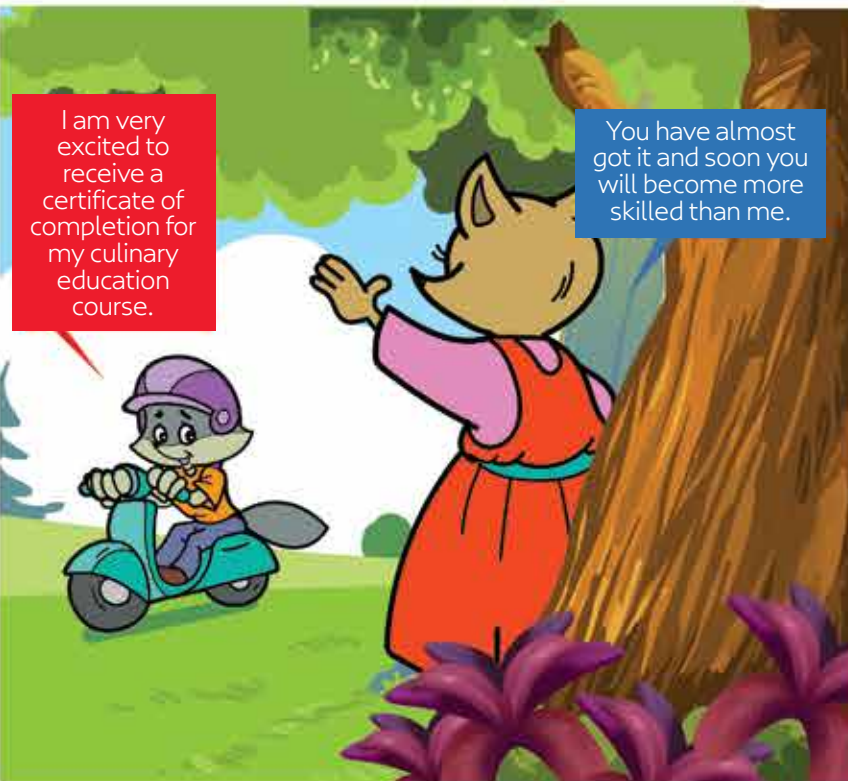




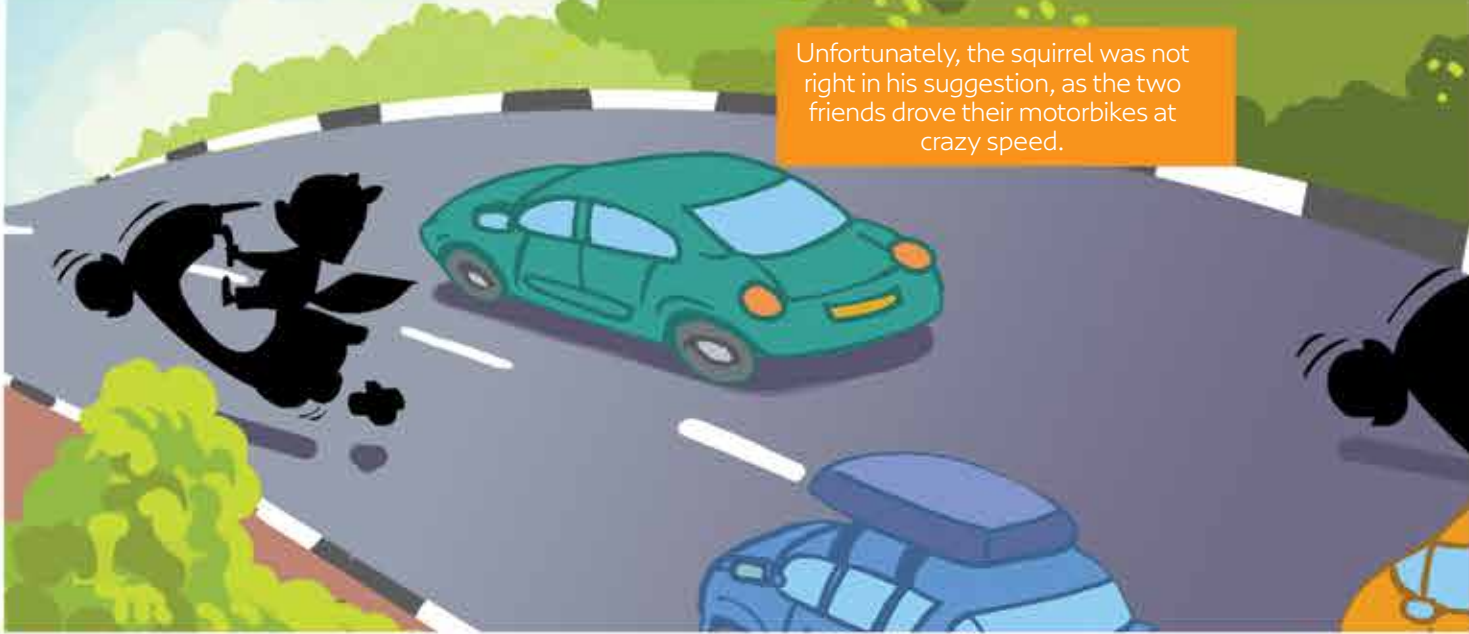


# Traffic Jungle

They violated the traffic and safety law, and spread fear and chaos in the street.

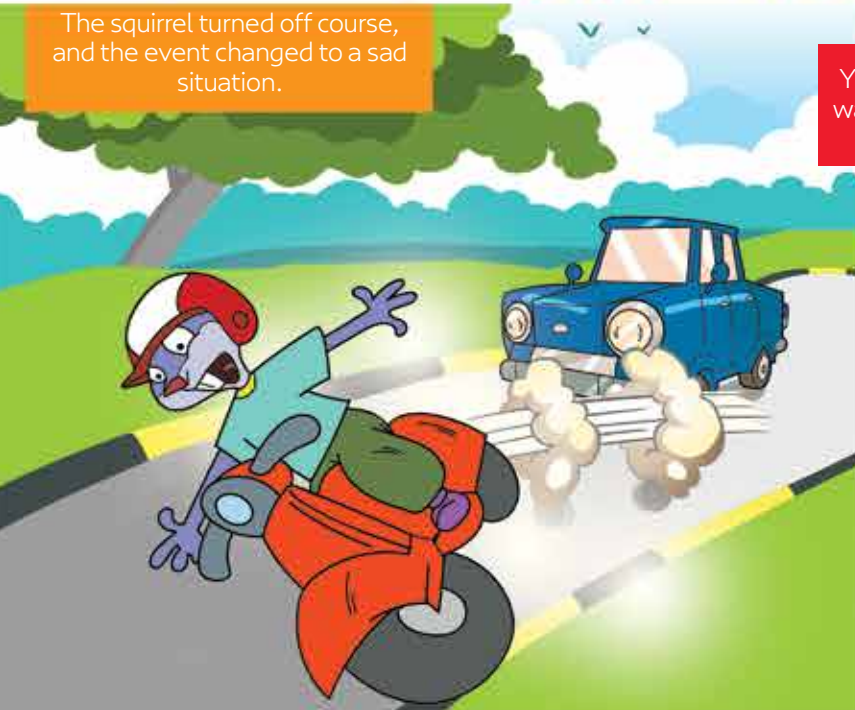


The squirrel lost control of his bike due to excessive speed and veered out of his lane.

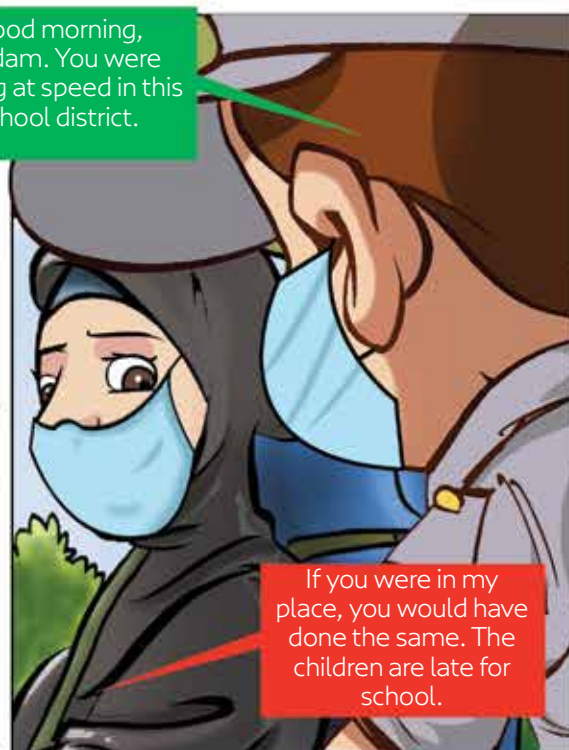
## Slow down while driving

Good morning, madam. You were driving at speed in this school district.

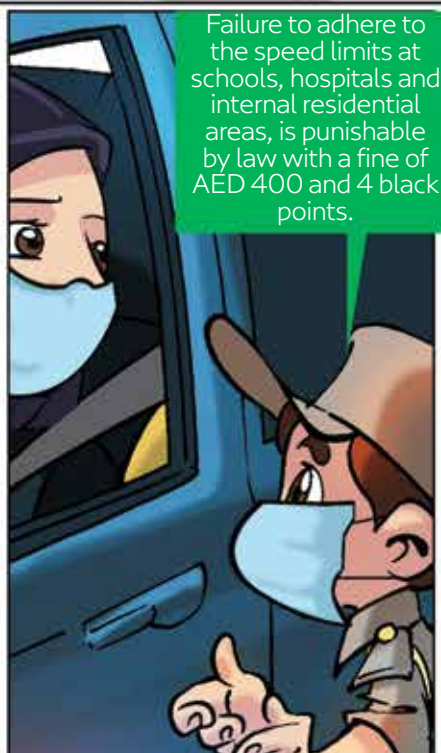


If you were in my place, you would have done the same. The children are late for school.

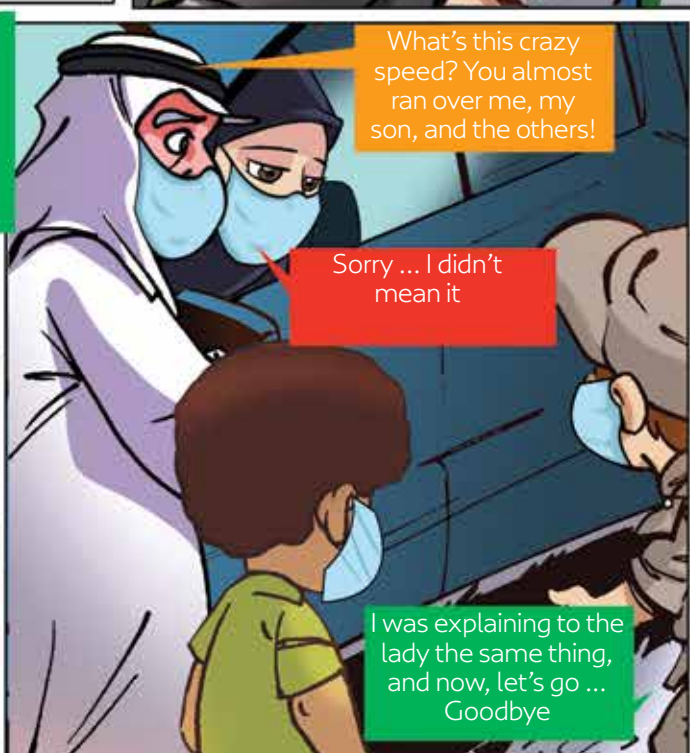


Of course, I will not commit such a violation because it endangers everyone's life. As for being late, you can come a little bit earlier.

What's this crazy speed? You almost ran over me, my son, and the others!

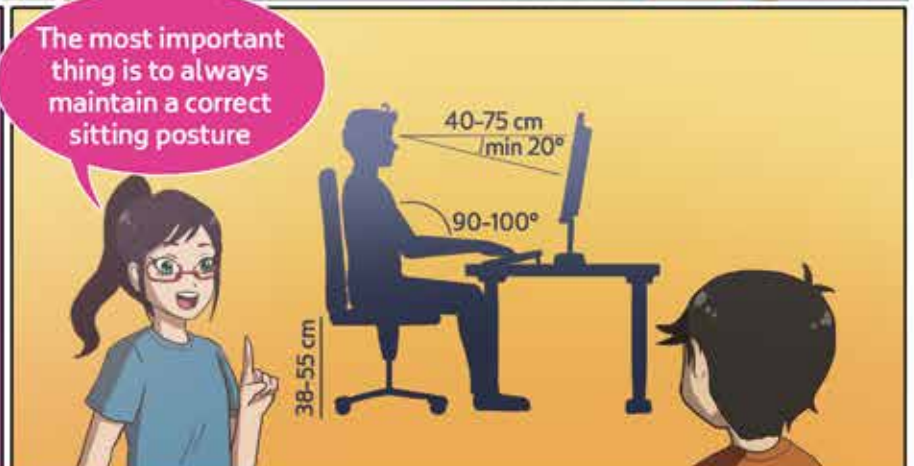
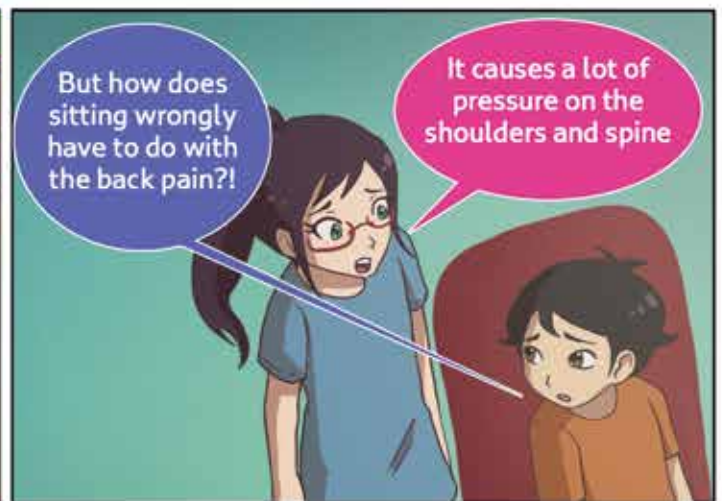

## Bicycle Safe Driving Part 3
