### Stay Safe

Hello Dear friends..

Bicycles have multiple benefits, be it as a means of exercise or an environmentally friendly mobility means. So make sure to use bikes safely, my friends. For your safety and the safety of others, RTA has set regulations for cycling, which include:

- Bicycles should be ridden on designated tracks.

- Cycling is not allowed on roads with speed exceeding 60 km/h.
- Cyclists must wear a protective helmet and a reflective jacket.
- Cyclists must dismount when crossing pedestrian crossings.
- Any person under 12 years is not allowed to ride a bicycle on a road or cycling track unless accompanied by a person who is not less than 18 years.

## Seasonal Flu




Hello friends. Seasonal influenza generally affects the respiratory system, mainly the nose and throat, and its effect can vary from mild to severe symptoms.



Most people affected with the flu recover within a few days, but children under two are more likely to develop serious flu-related complications.

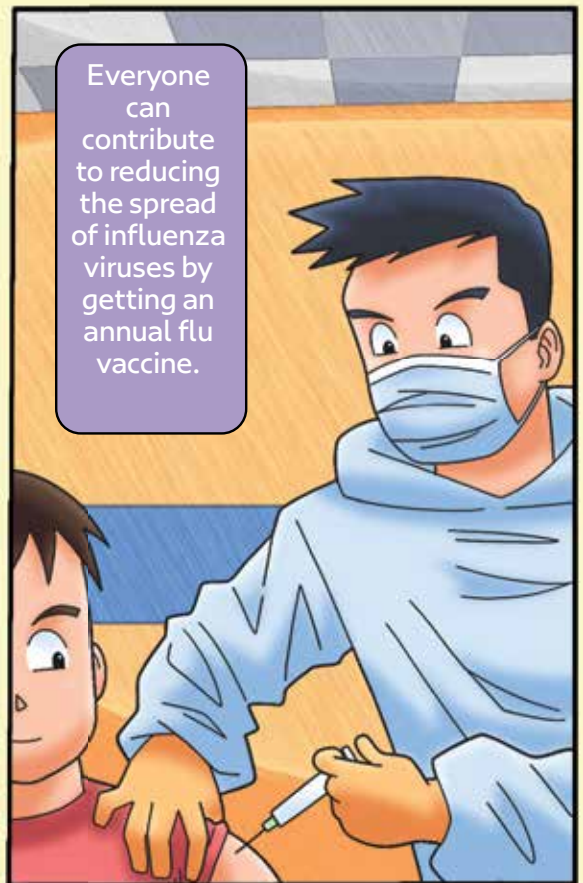

Vaccination is very important, especially for children under five, because they are more likely to transmit the disease to others, and the vaccine is available to everyone starting from the age of 6 months.



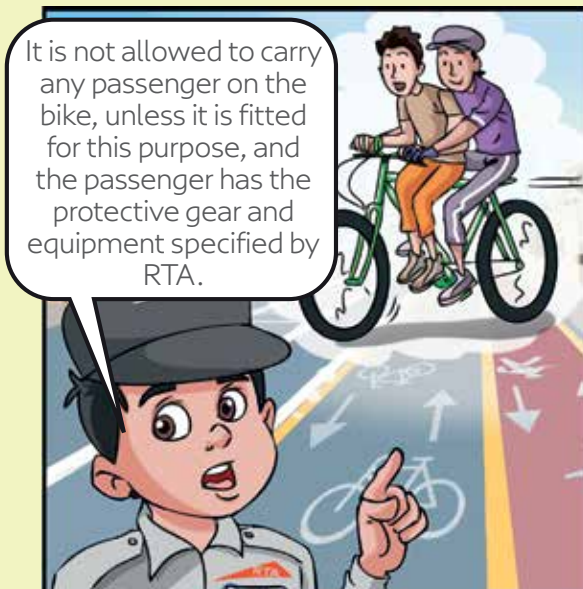
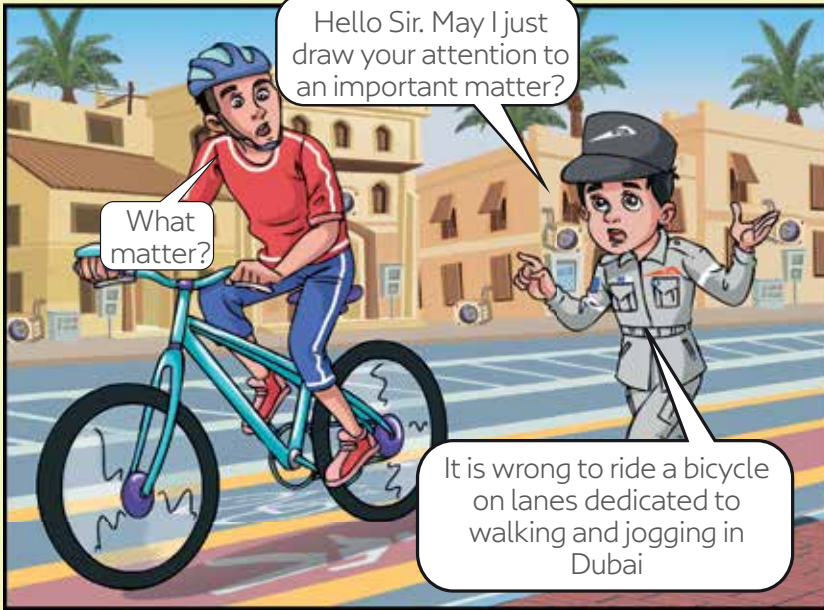

RTA is keen to actively participate in social, humanitarian and charitable activities on various occasions as such events consolidate the values of giving and bringing joy to the hearts of children and their families



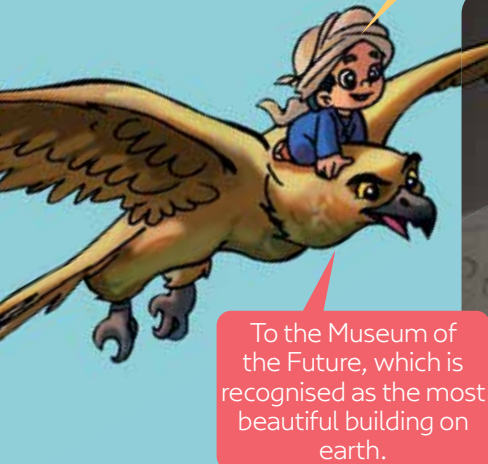

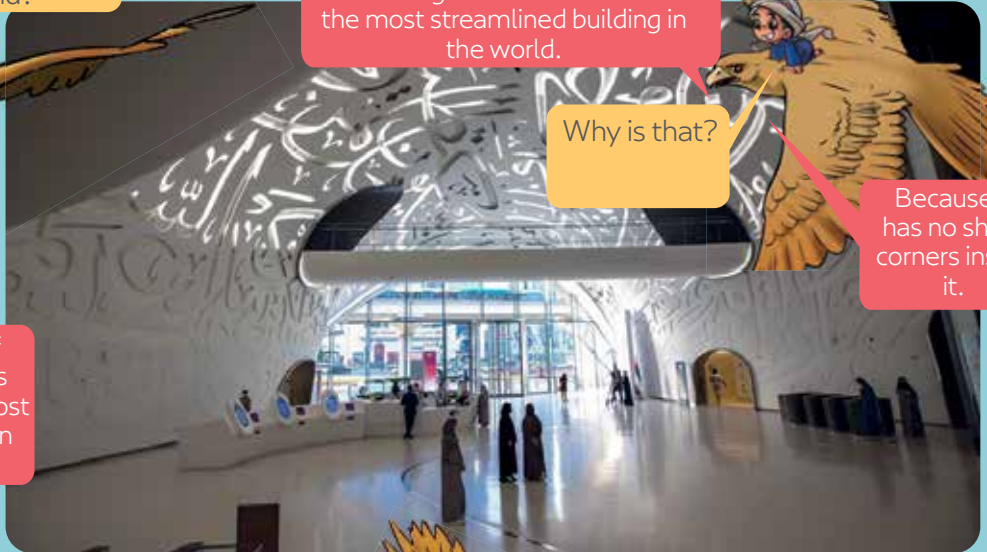
## Museum of the Future (Part 1)

Why is that?

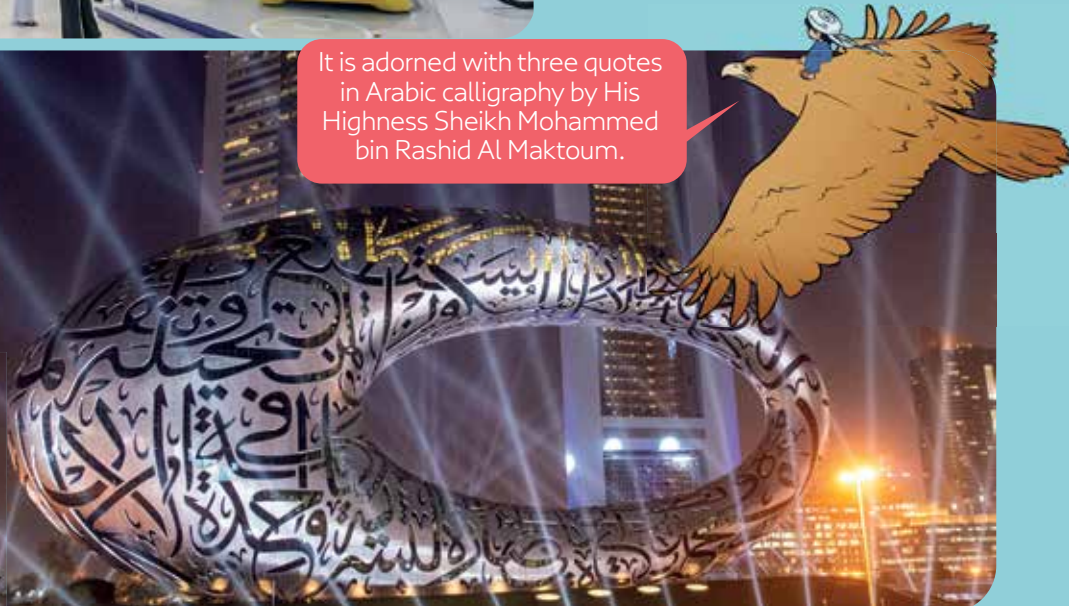
Because it has no sharp corners inside it.

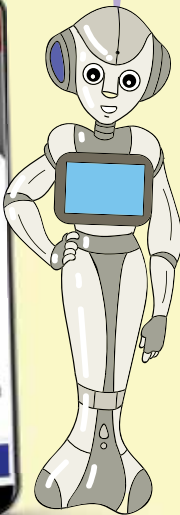
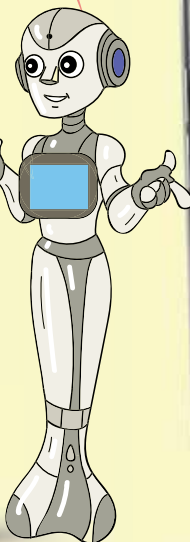
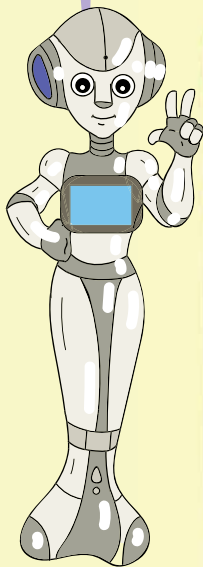
“My City” platform aims to keep our streets safe by reporting road-related problems, raise the level of safety and maintain the beauty of Dubai



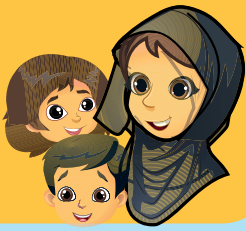
Through the platform, users can submit reports, upload photos, select the site, explain the problem and complete the details.

The report is directed to the concerned department, where it will be examined. The initiator will be registered for reward according to the approved procedures

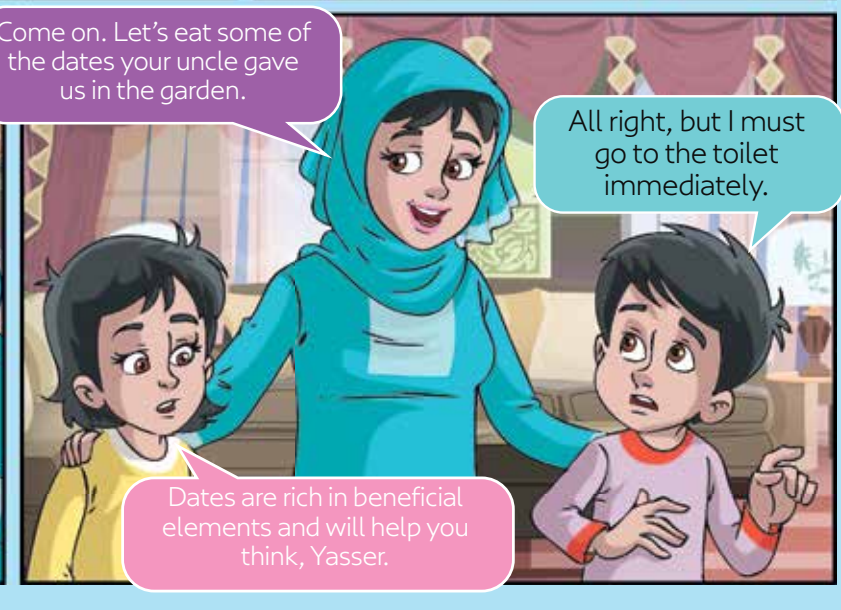
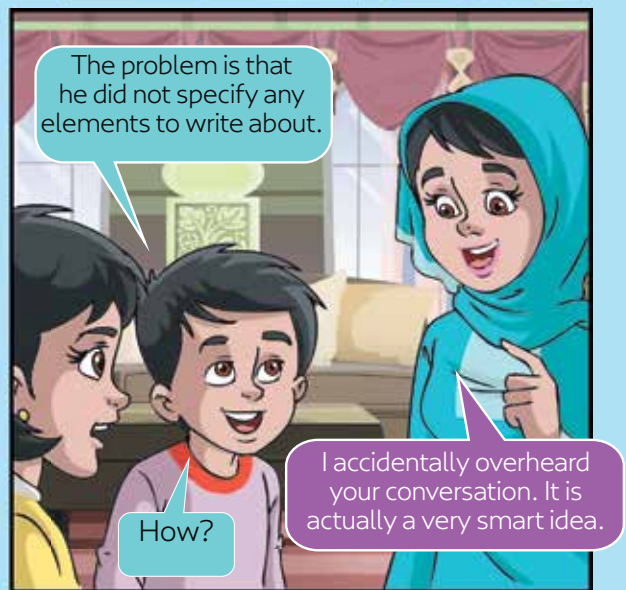
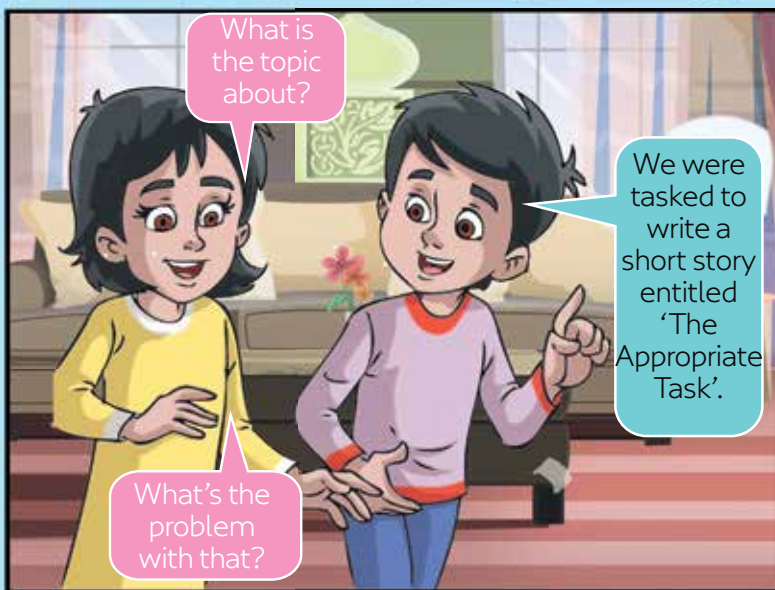
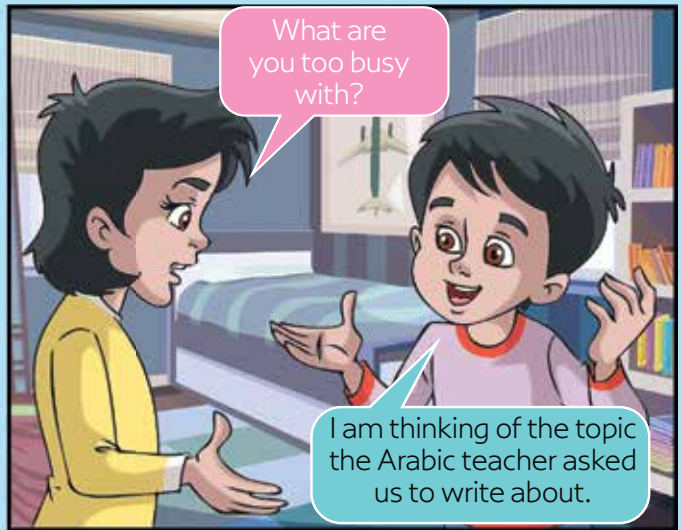




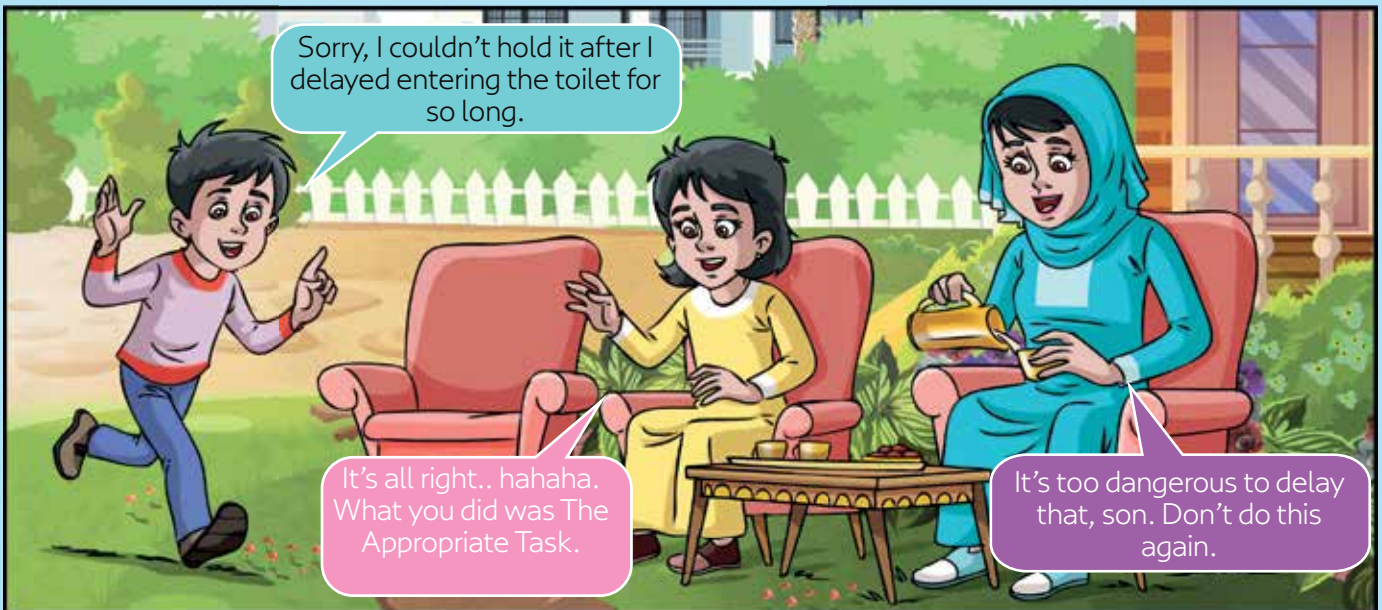
