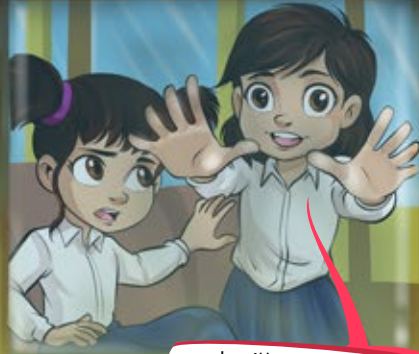

I understand, and from today I will abide by the safety rules onboard the school bus. I will never stand while the bus is in motion.



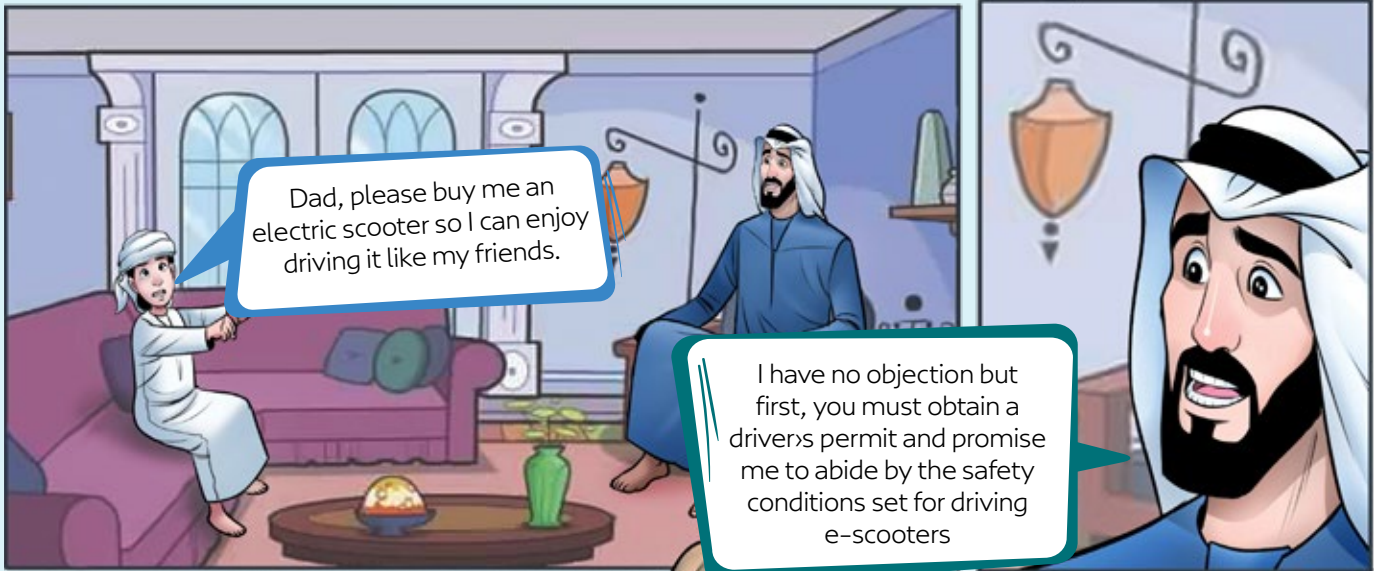

I understand, Dad. I promise to abide by the safety conditions as you told me.

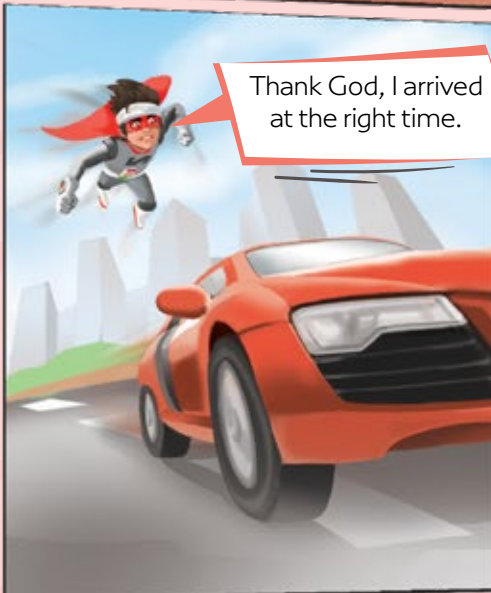




In the solar system, Mars is the fourth planet from the sun, after Mercury, Venus, and Earth.



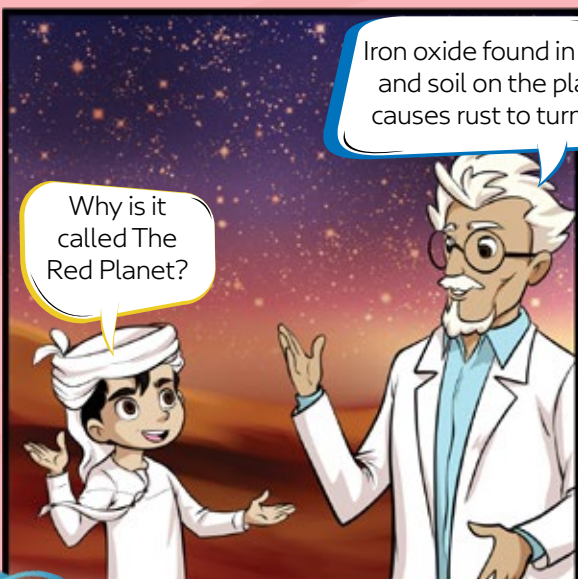
Because it is similar to planet Earth in terms of its geological composition. It also has four seasons, just like planet Earth.

Like our planet, it also has ice packs covering its southern and northern poles

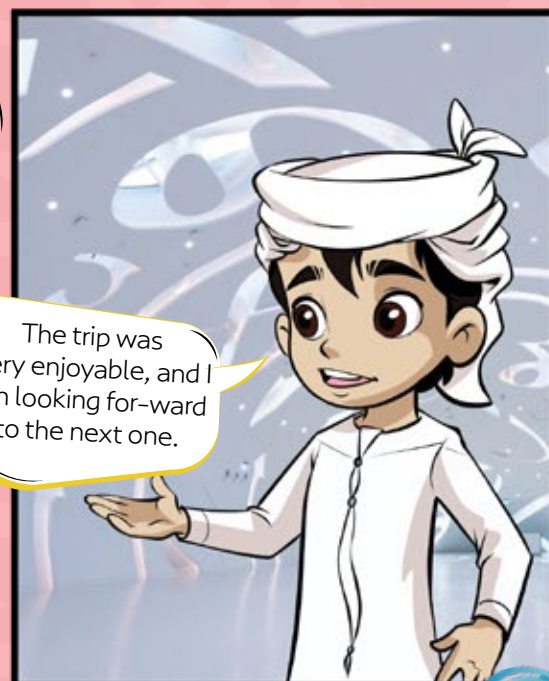
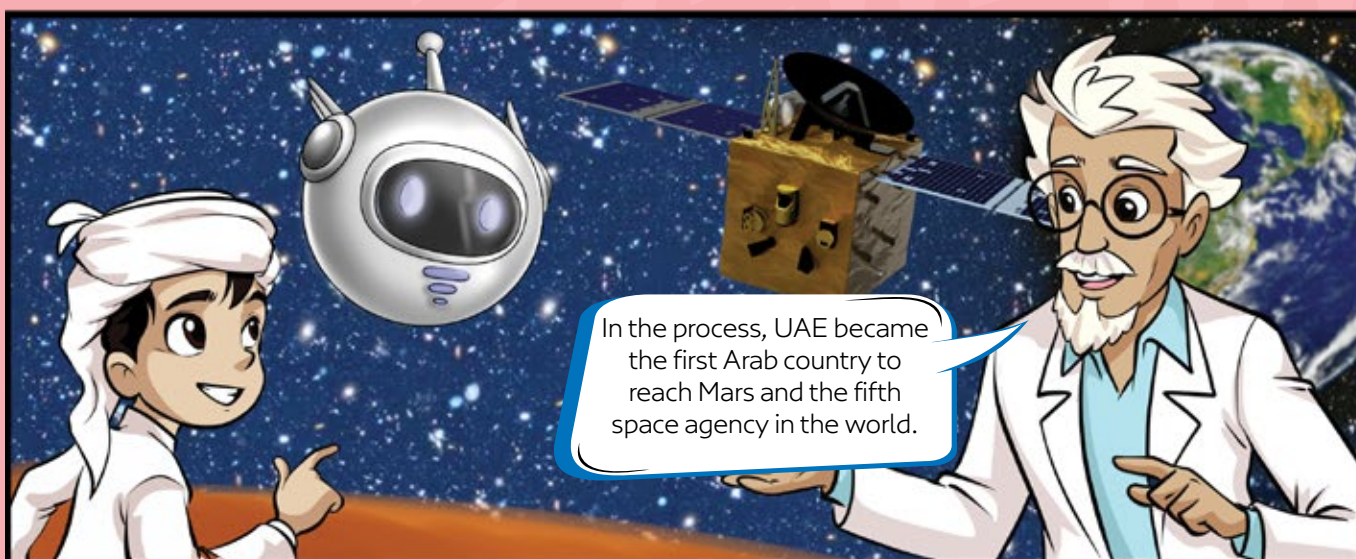
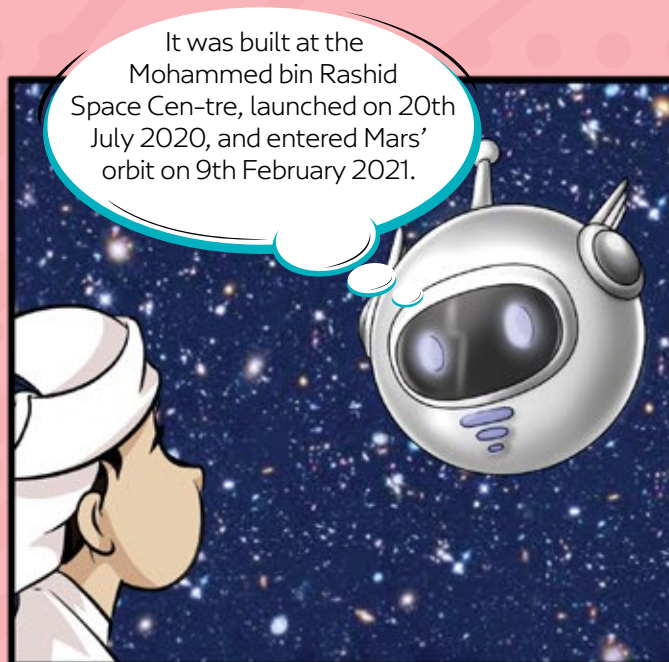
The two moons of Mars are called Phobos and Deimos

Iron oxide found in rocks and soil on the planet causes rust to turn red.





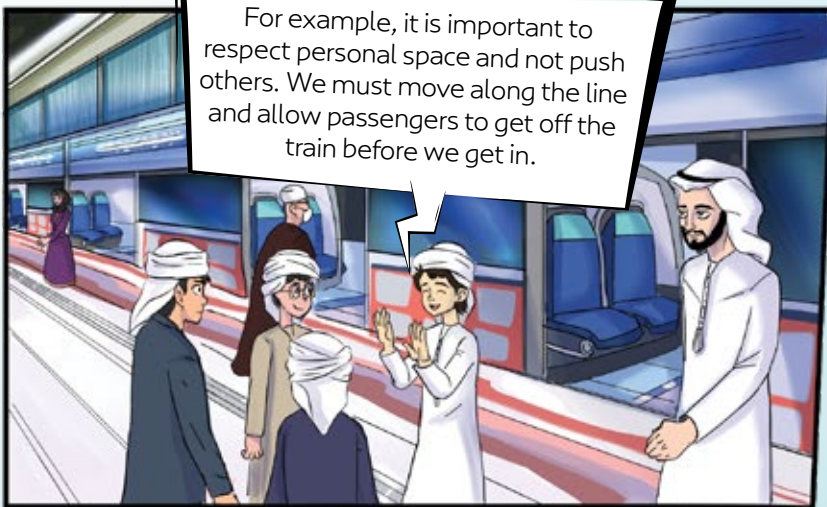

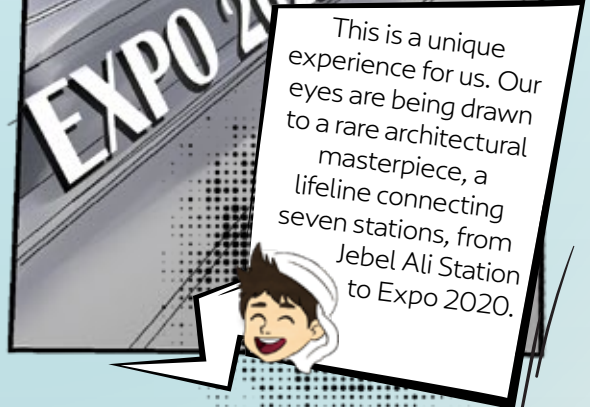

As a global destination, Dubai Metro gives our emirate a futuristic edge.

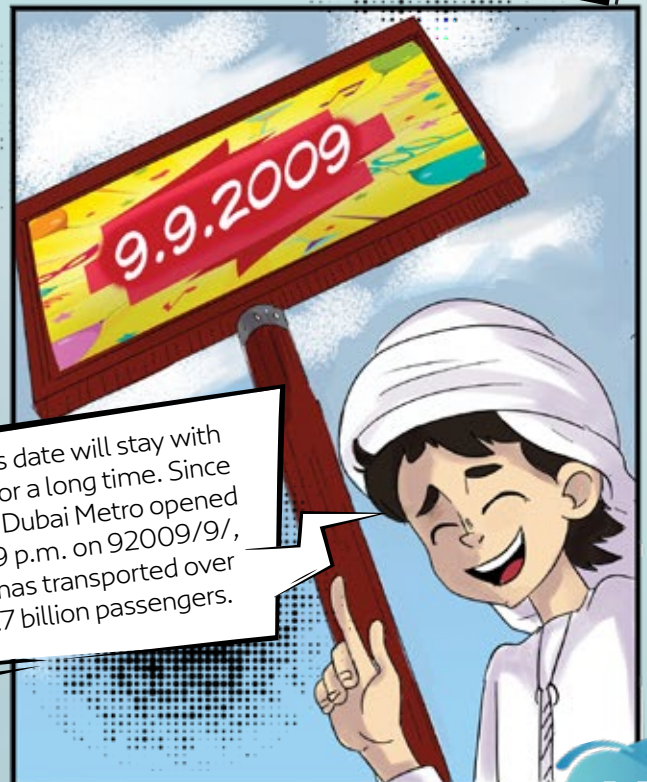

The Dubai Metro also links people to their favourite places, homes, and workplaces, as well as all the aesthetic and cultural landmarks of Dubai.

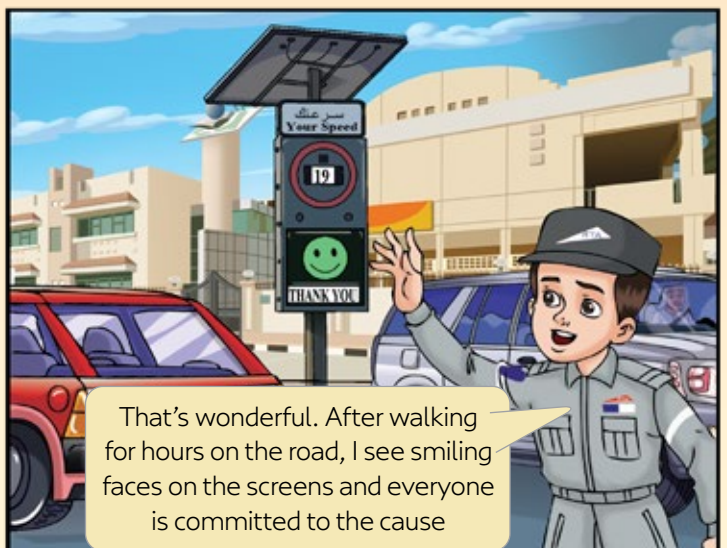
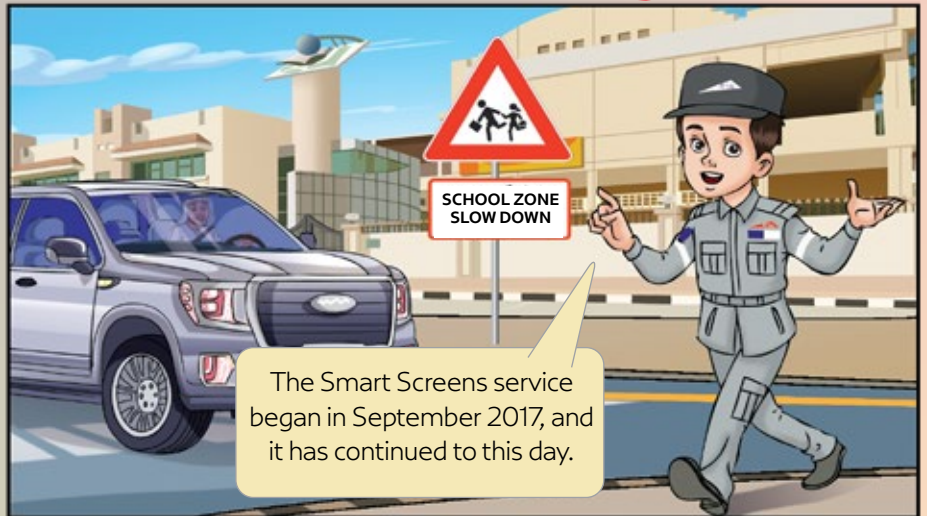


This date will stay with us for a long time. Since the Dubai Metro opened at 9 p.m. on 9/2009/9/, it has transported over 1.7 billion passengers.

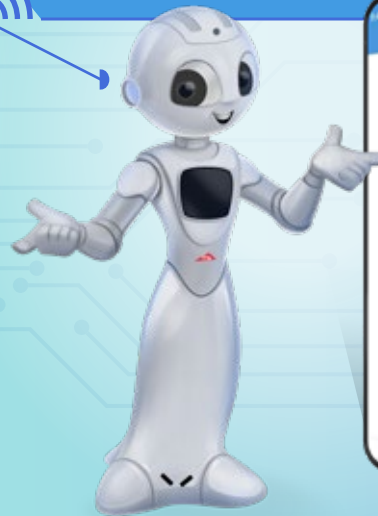

Hello friends. In this issue I will talk about S'hail app – the perfect app to help you get around Dubai quickly and easily.

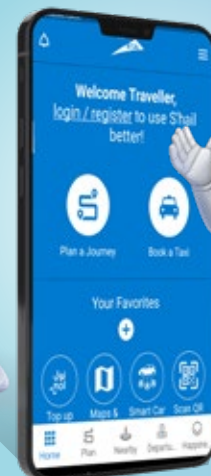
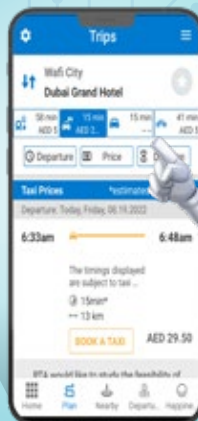
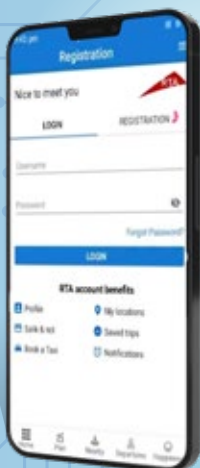
S'hail app covers the following modes of transport: public buses, Dubai Metro, marine transport means, Dubai Tram, Dubai Taxi, Uber and Careem services, limousine and Hala Taxi.



S'hail offers a variety of services to help you plan your trip. To use the services, follow the steps below:
Click on Plan a Journey, enter your destination, enter departure time, and click on Search. Scroll down to find your preferred mode of transport and select the route that suits you the best.

To book a taxi, log-in, then click on Book a Taxi. Enter your destination, select departure time, and click on Search.

Choose one of the following options: a regular taxi, or ladies' taxi, to get the journey time and approximate fare.

Lets talk about ways to prevent asthma, and as you know: Prevention is better than cure.

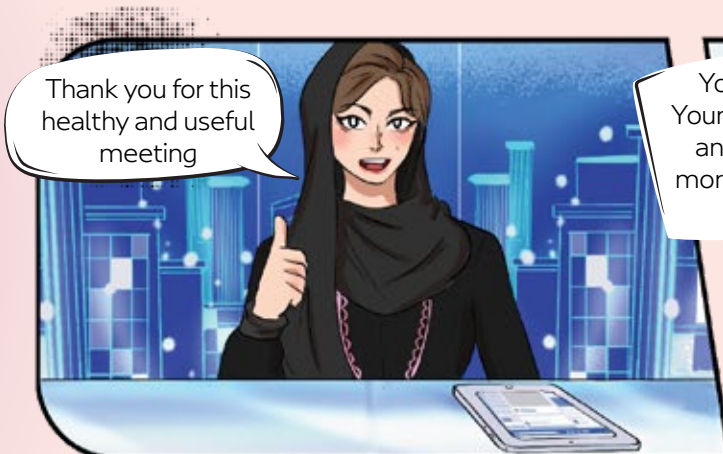
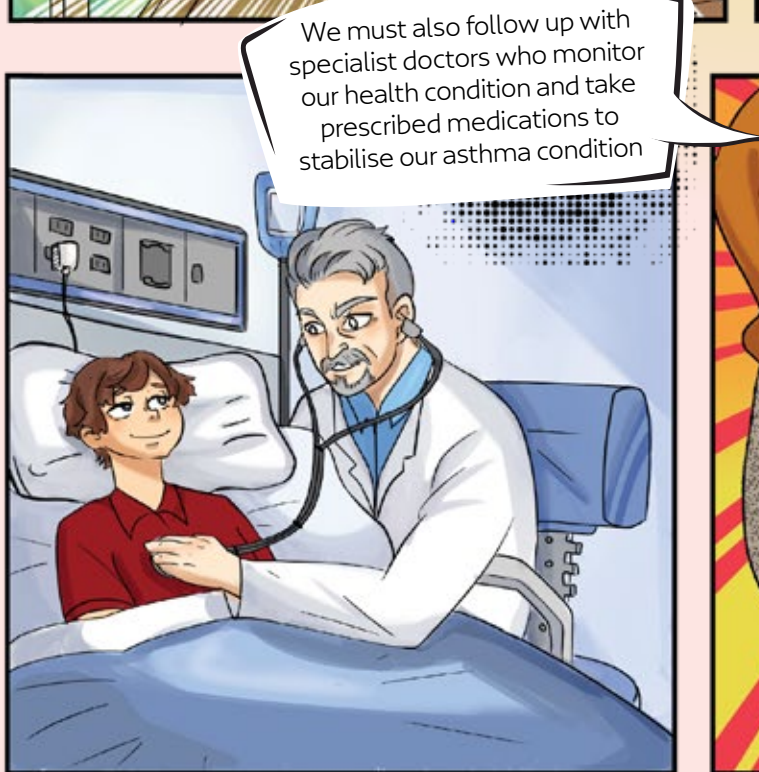


It is important to stay away from dust and dirt, which are plentiful in the summer, and in damp areas.

The geography, history, and Nature of Hatta

Hatta is one of the prominent landmarks and tourist destinations in the UAE thanks to its distinctive attractions and landscapes. Located in the Emirate of Dubai, Hatta is characterized by abundant landscapes, most notably the towering mountains. The climate of the city of Hatta is cooler than downtown Dubai, due to its location in a mountainous area, with a relatively mild climate in the summer and less hot in the evening.

The history of Hatta city goes back 3,000 years and is classified as one of the oldest areas in the UAE. In the past, it was called (Al-Hajarain) due to the two mountains that guard its northern and southern borders, which are among the most famous mountains in the Emirates.



Hatta Lake

is formed at the Hatta Dam situated between the mountains. It is a destination for adventure enthusiasts. The area also attracts camping lovers and is ideal for practising sailing. Among the recreational destinations is Wadi Hub with lots of recreational areas featuring a bunch of local restaurants, the Happiness Farm and the Sunrise Farmhouse.

Sanad Card offers the following benefits and discounts that make government and private services more accessible to People of Determination: Discounts in restaurants and entertainment, commercial and public services, tourism and hotel discounts, health and rehabilitation services, educational and judicial services, and supplies and support devices.
