





Salama Council sensitises students about security and safety of recreational motorcycles

The drive aims to raise the public awareness

during the winter

Salama magazine family hosted an interactive gathering with Year 12 students from the National Charity School, Dubai, to stress the importance of adhering to safety and security controls when riding recreational motorcycles. The event aimed at raising the awareness of students to avoid accidents and injuries that may result from reckless driving and excessive speeds. During the event, attendees listened to the experiences of students who suffered severe injuries that caused them physical and psychological damage.

The students praised the efforts of the General Department of Criminal Investigations of Dubai Police, and the Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) for the awareness campaign targeting rental offices of recreational motorcycles to follow up on their compliance with the security and safety requirements. The requirements include providing designated dress for riding recreational motorcycles, and avoiding renting motorcycles with expired licenses, or to persons who are medically unfit or under 16.

Awareness and **Monitoring Campaigns** Muhannad Khalid Muhairi, Director of Licensing Activities, Roads and Transport Authority (RTA), said, "In collaboration with Dubai Police, RTA is carrying out continuous awareness and monitoring campaigns on entertainment motorbikes rental offices to ensure that they are aware of RTA's security and safety controls applicable to their business. He added: "These campaigns are particularly important considering the influx of tourists and community members of different age groups to desert areas to enjoy the wintry conditions with their families and friends including riding entertainment motorbikes. "The campaigns focus on compliance with the stipulated number of riders of entertainment motorbikes and that the motorbikes are driven within the speed limits specified for each age bracket. The campaigns also verify the compliance of rental offices to provide riding gears in different sizes, and make sure that entertainment motorbikes are not rented to anyone who is not medically fit, or under 16 years unless with the

Informing Parents
Student, Mahmoud Samara,
expressed admiration for the
sport of driving recreational
motorcycles, especially in winter
with friends. To be safe, Mahmoud
Samara advised the youth to adhere
to the safety rules and inform parents
in the event of unexpected incidents or
breakdowns, besides keeping parents
informed regarding the site of the ride
and the return home time.

First Aid
Student, Abdullah Mahrous,
spoke about the importance of first
aid if the driver was subjected to a
traffic accident or was present at the
accident site and the situation required
the assistance of the injured person. One
of the most important aids is to check the
breathing of the injured person and look at the chest so
that breathing can be heard and felt. The injured person
must be moved to a safe area, bearing in mind that
dealing with fractures and wounds requires tying
them. In the case of amputation, they must
be covered immediately with a bandage
or pressure bandage.

Checking Motorcycles
Student, Ahmed Masaad,
said, "Recreational motorcycle
riding is one of the most important
winter hobbies that require
compliance with security and safety
requirements. That includes checking
the tires of recreational motorcycles and making
sure that the license of the used motorcycle is
not expired. He also advised young people to
be careful and to deal with rental offices that are
committed to the law.

He added: "When taking the recreational motorcycle from the rental office, we make sure that the necessary equipment for firefighting and first aid is available, record personal data, the date and time of rental and its duration, and review the introductory guide to public safety procedures before driving the recreational motorcycle."

Ali Student. Youssef. talked about the experiences of friends who were subjected to significant traffic accidents as a result of driving recklessly and going on desert rides without informing their parents. He said. «It is better to trust the family more than friends, especially in the situations that we experience outside the home. I also advise the youth to communicate with relatives when accidents occur and speak with them frankly."




















Maximum Parking Stay

DubaiNow App





Hello friends. The **DubaiNow** app is now available on Google Play, App Store and App Gallery - search for the **DubaiNow** app and download it.

DubaiNow is a single, convenient app that gives you to access a wide range of government services in Dubai, making it and simple to manage all of your government transactions in one place. Log in by typing your nationality, name, ID number, and all your personal data, and double-checking that they are correct.



One of the services offered through the app is the ability to pay for RTA public parking fees using a credit card.



The app also features
a function allowing
users to retrieve
their previous parking
ticket and view it on the
RTA App.

Upon opening the app, users will be able to locate the «Pay Public Parking Fees» feature prominently displayed at the top of the main page. After clicking on the 'Pay' button, the app will display a list of the nearby parking areas along with an interactive map indicating their locations. Additionally, the area code for each location will be displayed on the map.



Enter the vehicle information, select the number of hours preferred, and click on 'Confirm' to pay directly using a credit card.


