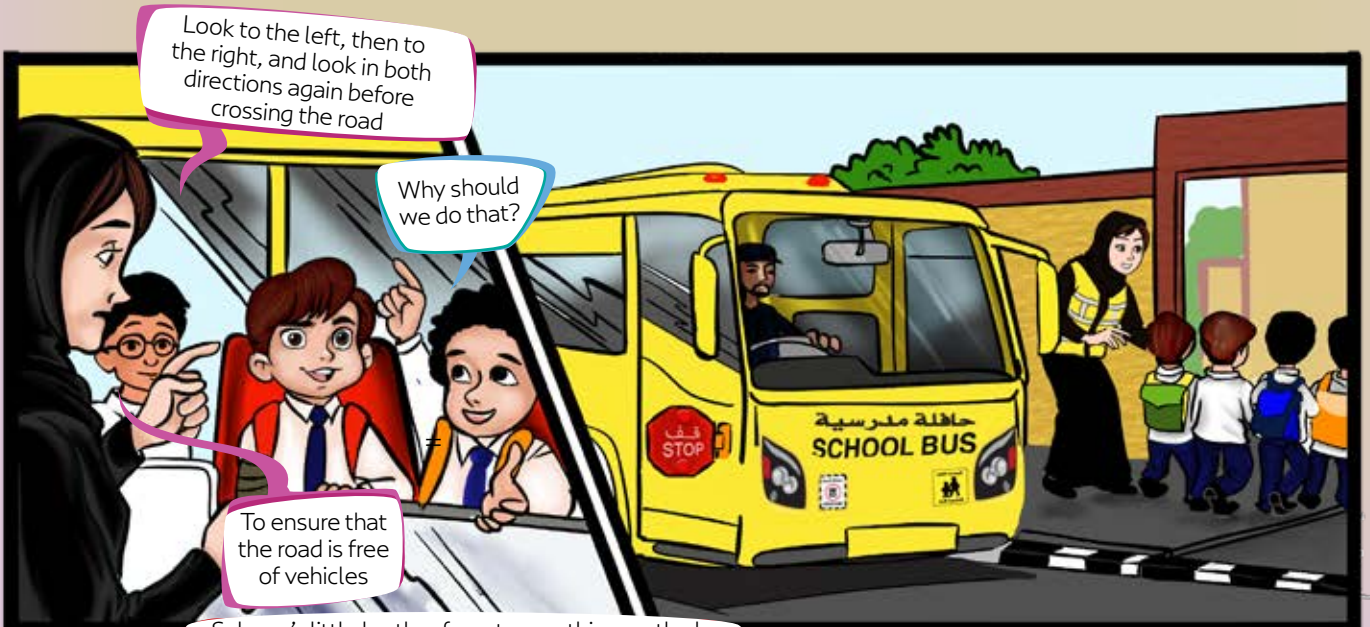

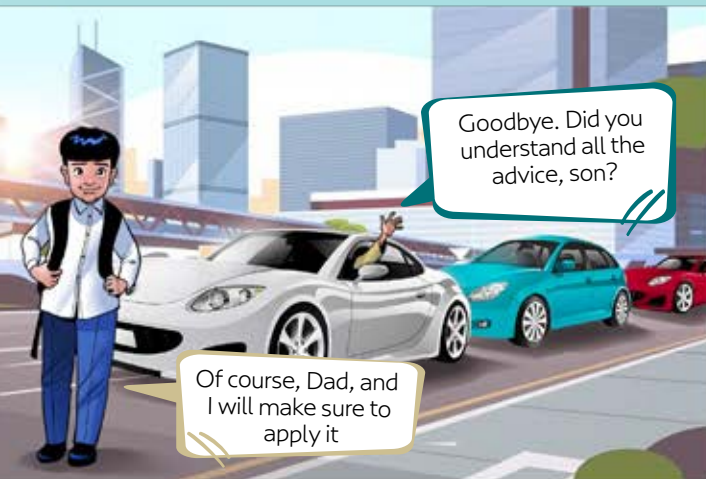

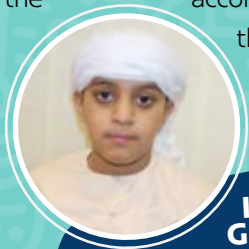

The Dubai frame provides
panoramic views of the city,
commemorating Dubai's history
from its inception to its ambitious
aspirations for future expansion.

The framework was unveiled in 2018.
It took around 2,000 tonnes of steel
and 2,900 square metres of laminated
glass to build.

The frame is
made of gold-
colored stainless
steel and features
rings inspired by
the Expo 2020
emblem

The frame is 150 meters high
and 95 meters wide, and it
is made up of two towers
connected by a bridge.



The bridge is permeated with a 25-metre-long transparent glass area that gives visitors a majestic feeling of walking in the air.

Don't worry, the glass is shatterproof and crafted from high-quality materials



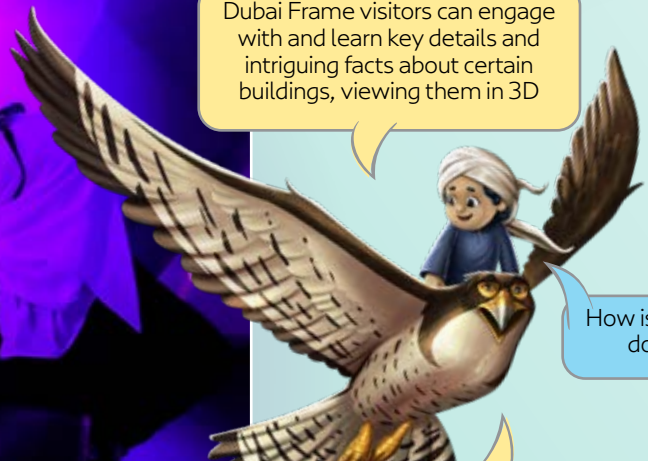
On the mezzanine floor, the frame offers visitors an exhibition of Old Dubai, telling its history through audio, visual, and sensory displays... and even through perfumes



The elevator to the Sky deck carries visitors 48 floors in just 75 seconds



Dubai Frame visitors can engage with and learn key details and intriguing facts about certain buildings, viewing them in 3D

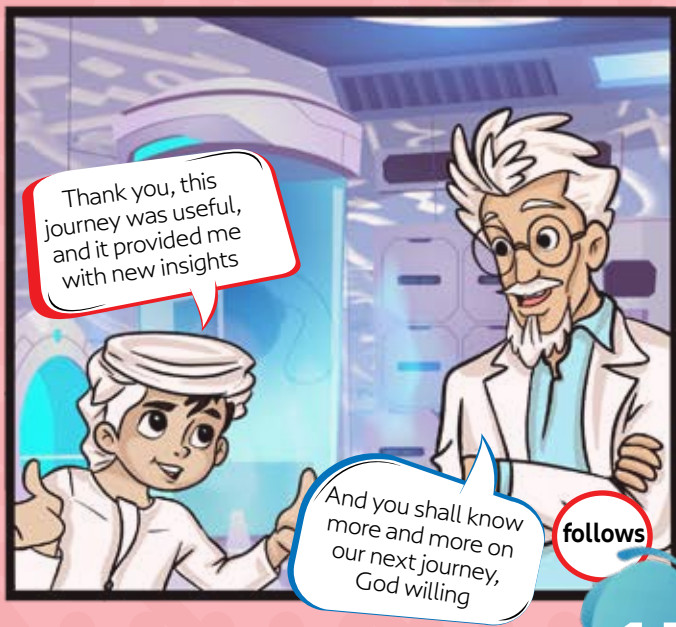
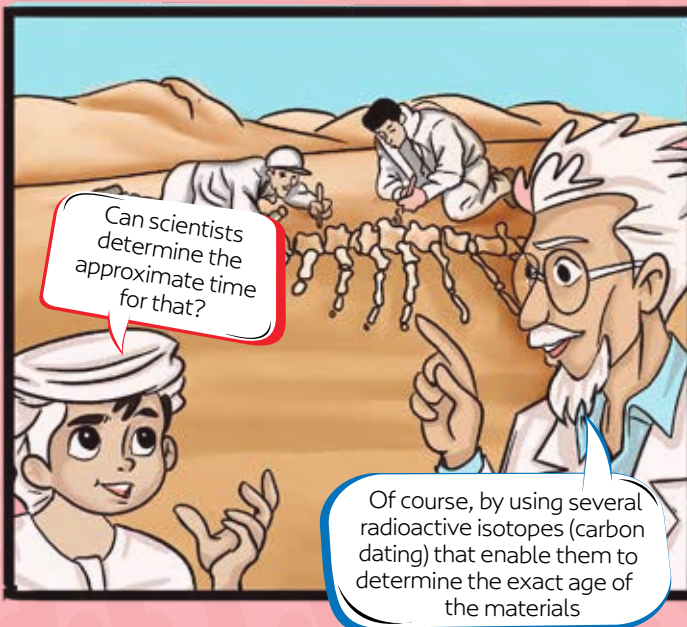
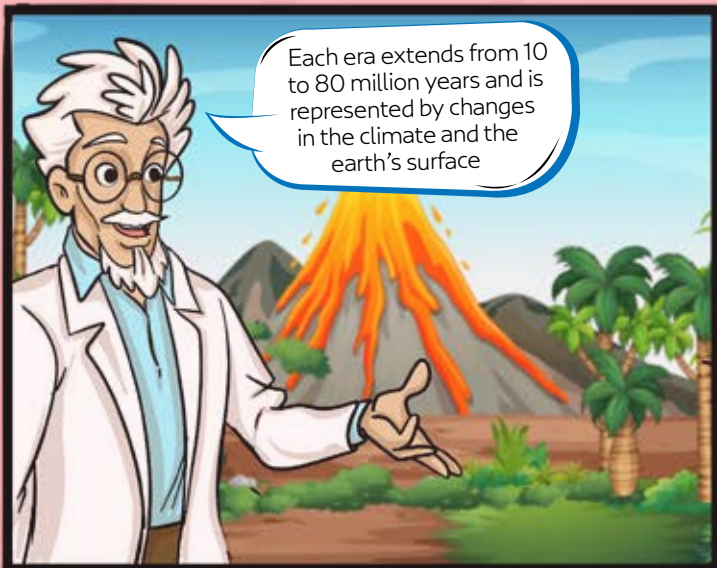
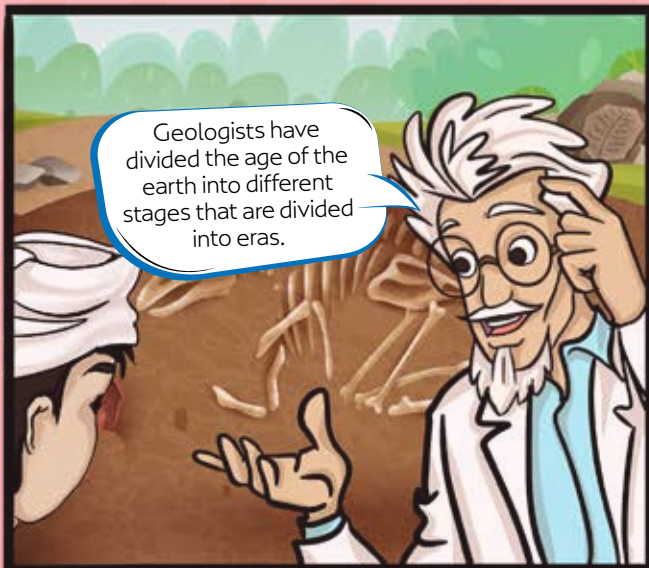
Geologists differ from most other scientists in dealing with time

Learn about smart pedestrian signals

After the positive results of the first phase, Dubai's Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) started the second phase of expanding the Smart Pedestrian Signals project in the emirate to include 10 new locations.

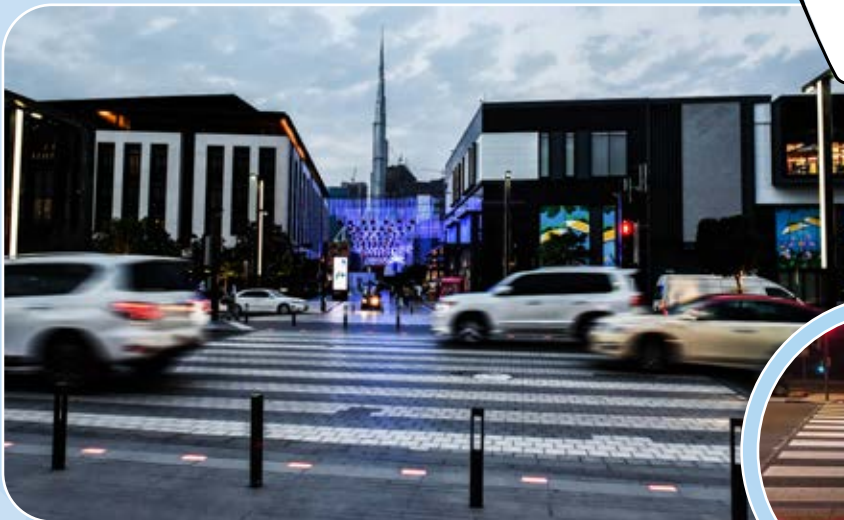
The Smart Pedestrian Signals technology is powered by a sensor-based system linked to a ground optical system on pavements and pedestrian crossings that works in tandem with the signal's light.

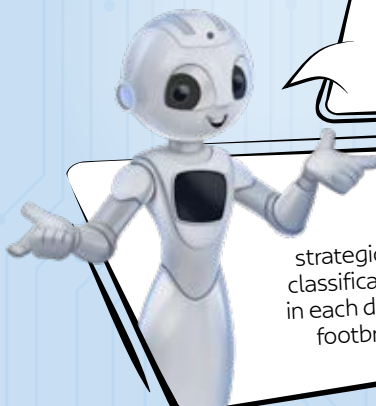


The sensors can feel the pedestrian movement on the pavement (before crossing the street) and on the pedestrian crossing (while crossing). This enhances pedestrian safety while also boosting the efficiency of traffic light operations and ensuring better management of signal timing.



The system provides enough time for pedestrians who require more time to cross, like people of determination, elderly residents, and kids.

The selection of locations for installing smart pedestrian signals is guided by criteria set in coordination with RTA's strategic partners, highlighted by the street classification (speed limit, number of lanes in each direction), locations & distance to footbridges, and the road design.



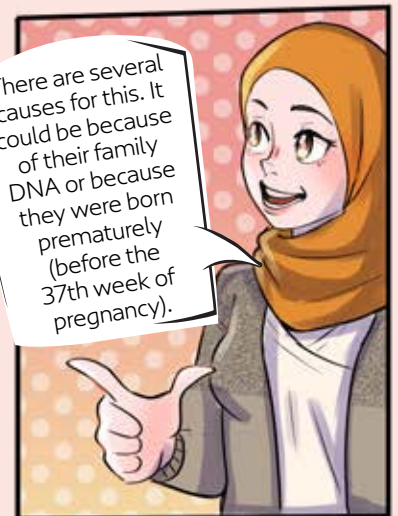
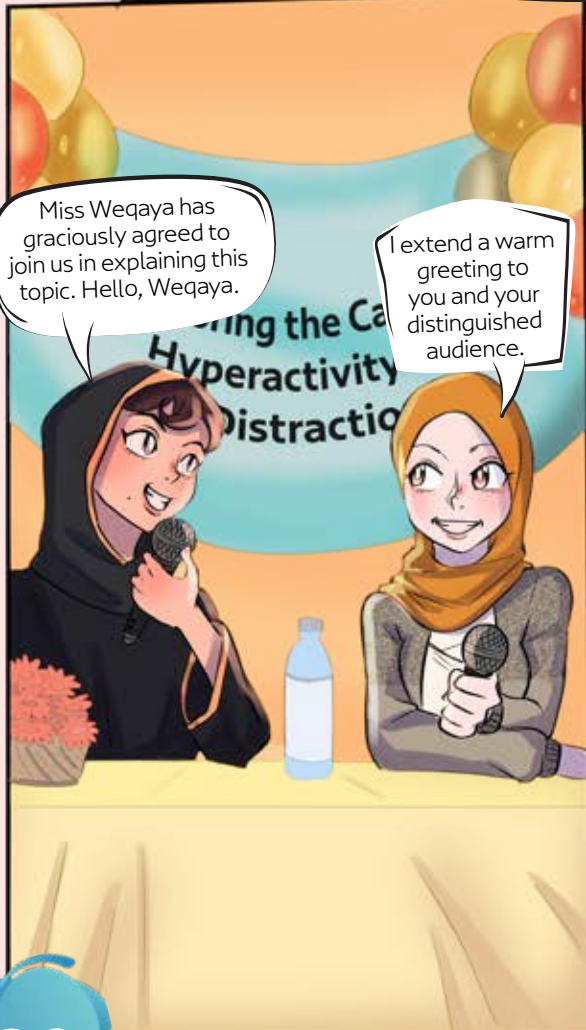
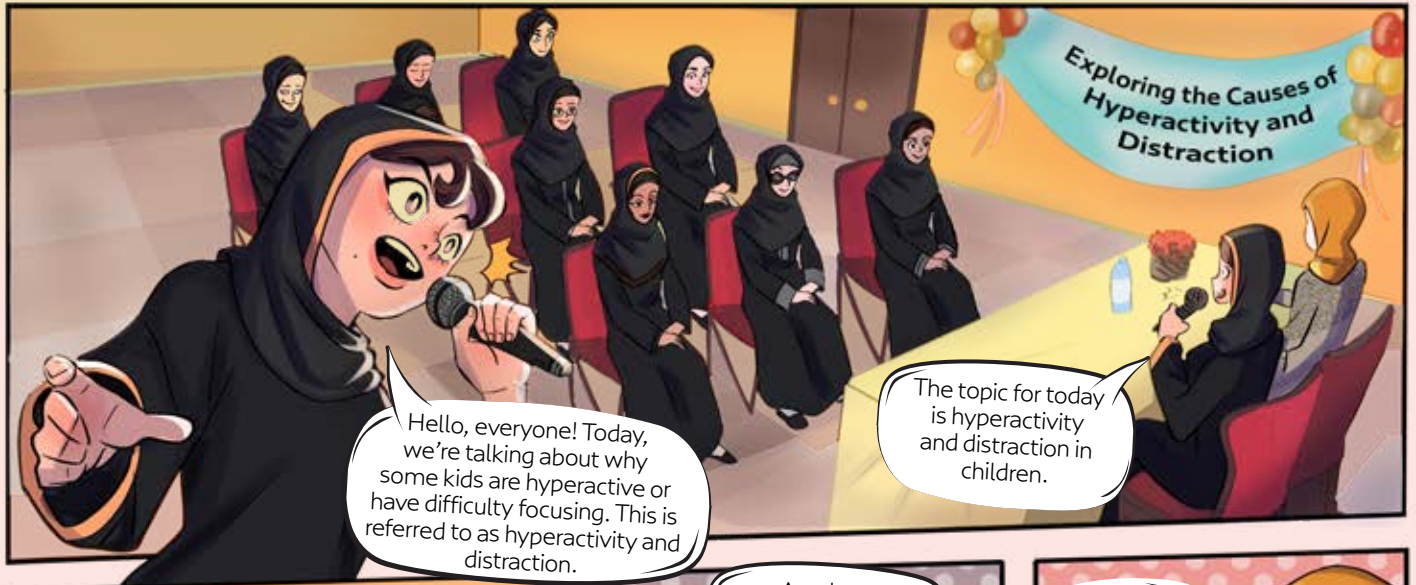
