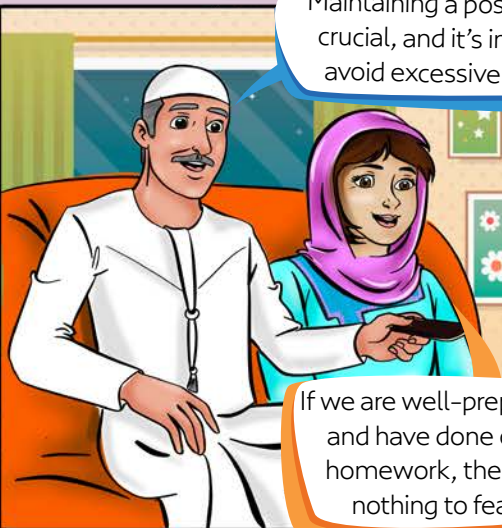

It's important to take the initiative and not postpone revision to the day before the test or the exam's day itself

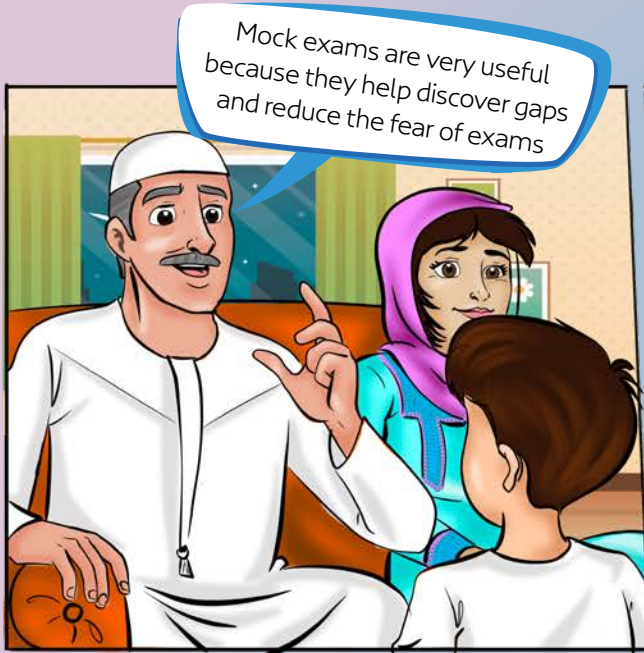


Concentrate by turning off your phone or switching it to 'Silent' and staying away from TV and social media while studying

Thank you, Mom and Dad, for these precious tips

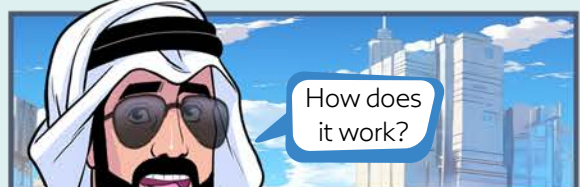
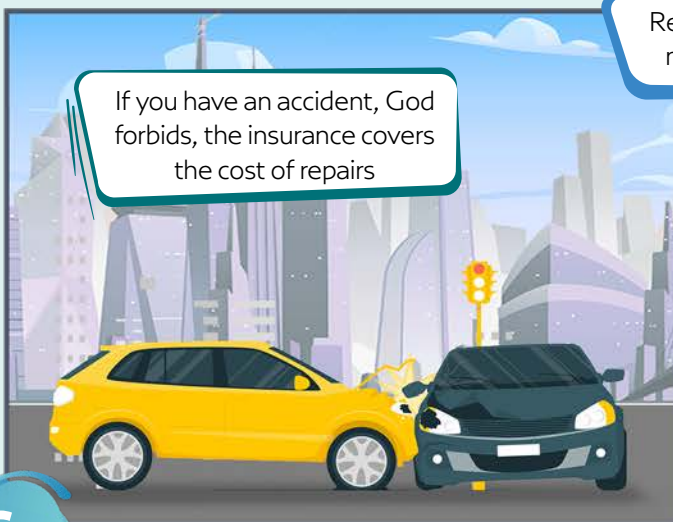

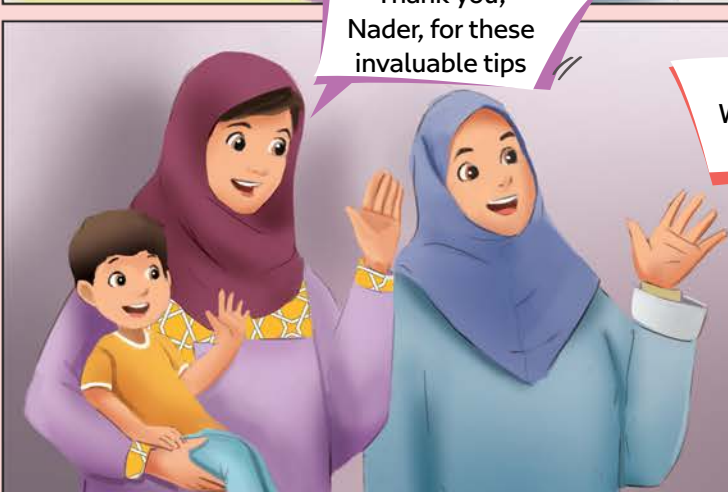

The Ski Academy offers special training for both kids and adults





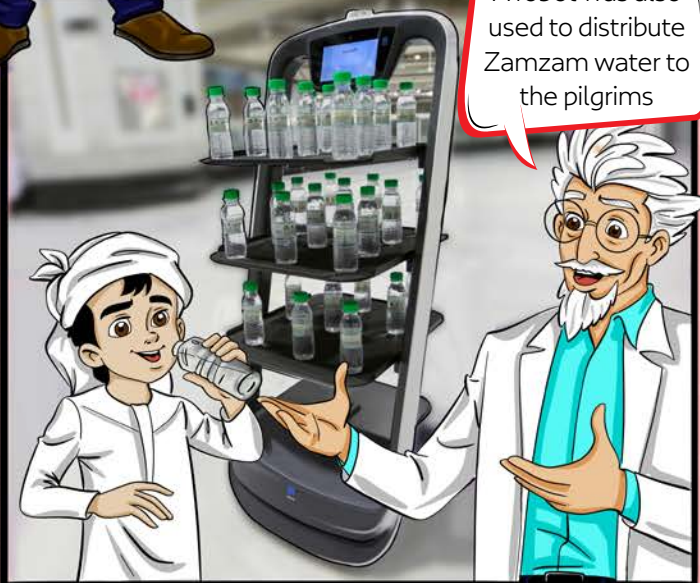
An amphibious ambulance was used to reach rugged areas that regular vehicles can't reach



The guidance robot gave out Islamic fatwas and advice. It is equipped with a touchscreen and can communicate in 11 languages.

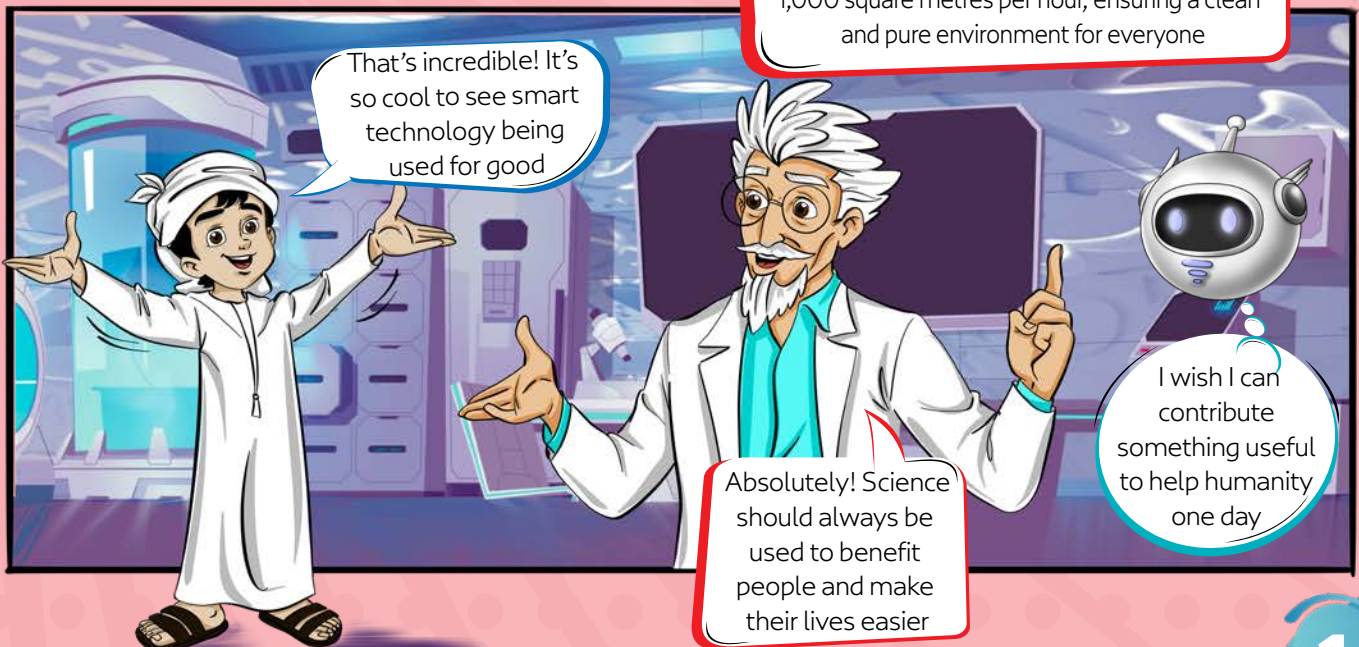


A robot was also used to distribute Zamzam water to the pilgrims

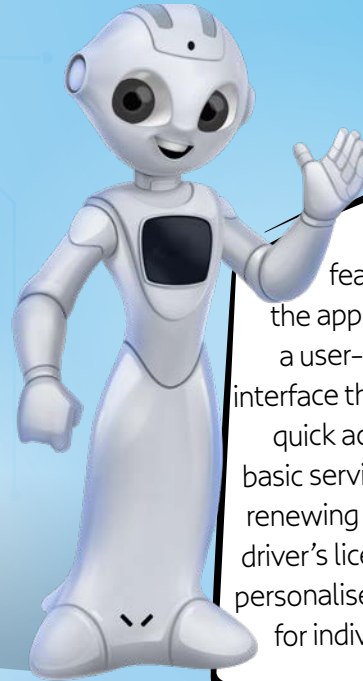


New version of 'RTA Dubai' App

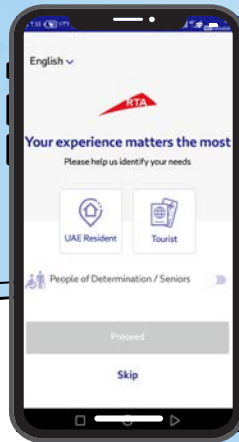

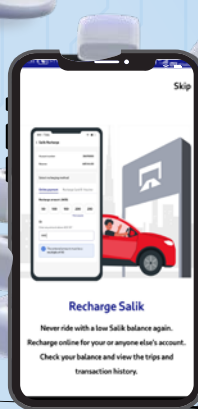
Dubai's Roads and Transport Authority (RTA) has released an updated version of 'RTA Dubai' App to enable users to interact smoothly with all RTA services



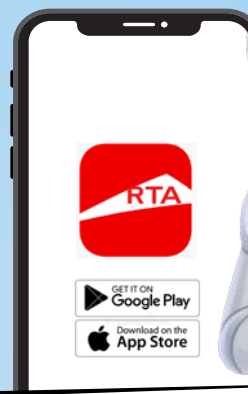
New features in the app include a user-friendly interface that provides quick actions for basic services such as renewing vehicle and driver's licences, and a personalised dashboard for individual use.



This upgrade constitutes a radical shift towards adopting a single-window solution to enhance customer satisfaction. The new version simplifies parking services by integrating them into a single screen.



The upgrades also covered various other aspects of the app, including Salik's online payments, top-ups, and nol card top-ups.



The new updated version of the App is now available for download on iOS and Android.

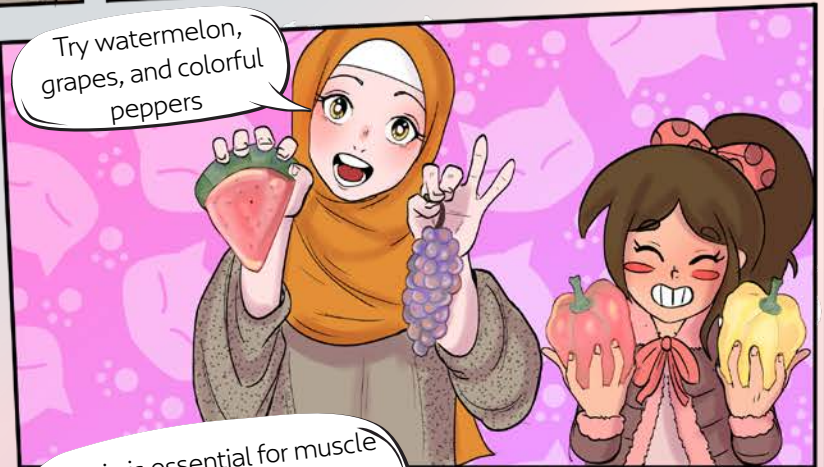
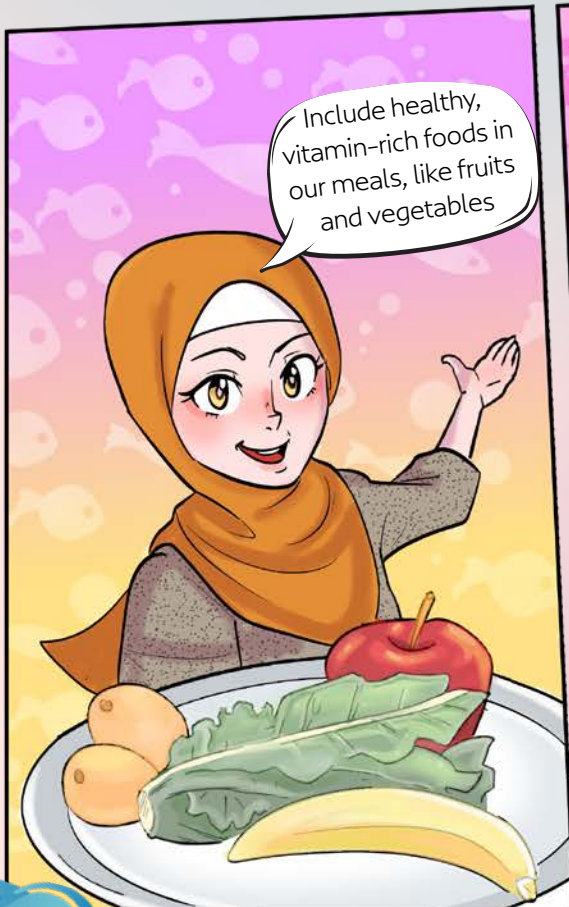
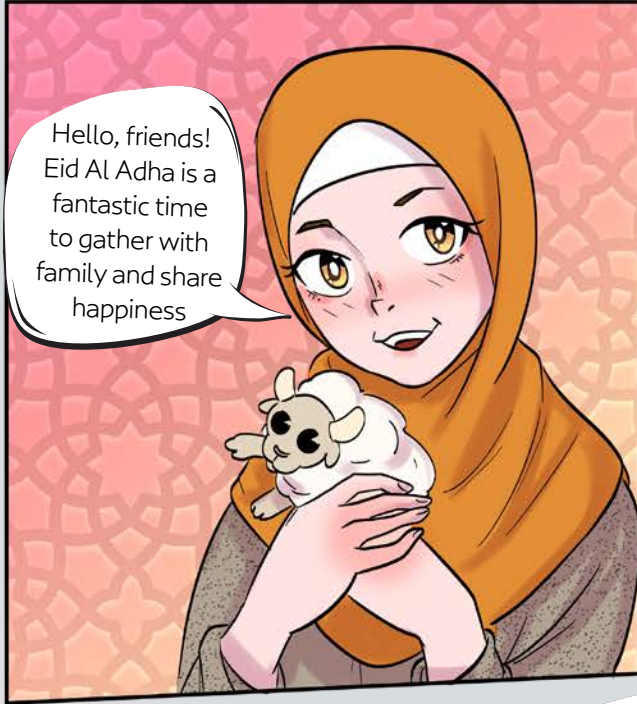

After the prayer, people return home to prepare and distribute the sacrifice.



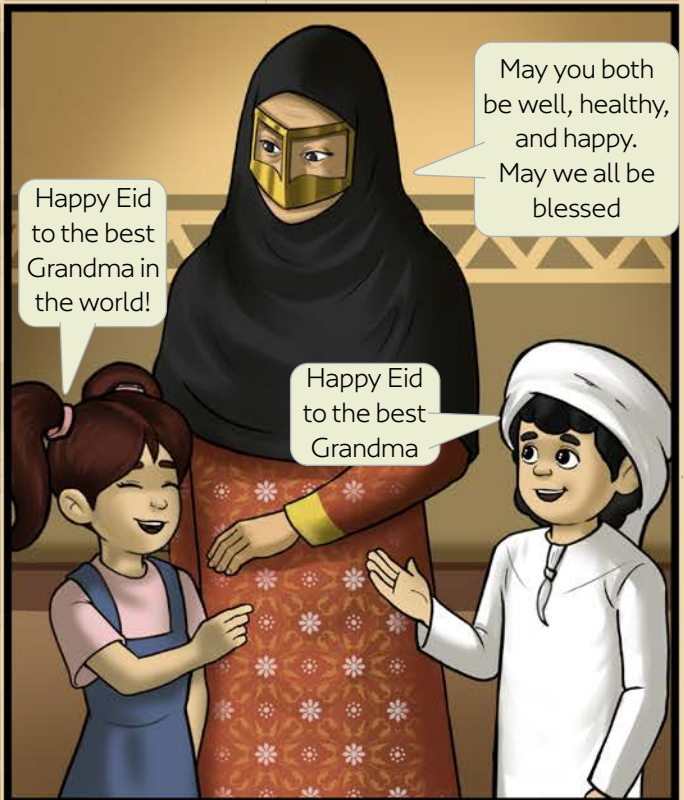
Then, visits begin, starting with those closest to us and moving to those further away.

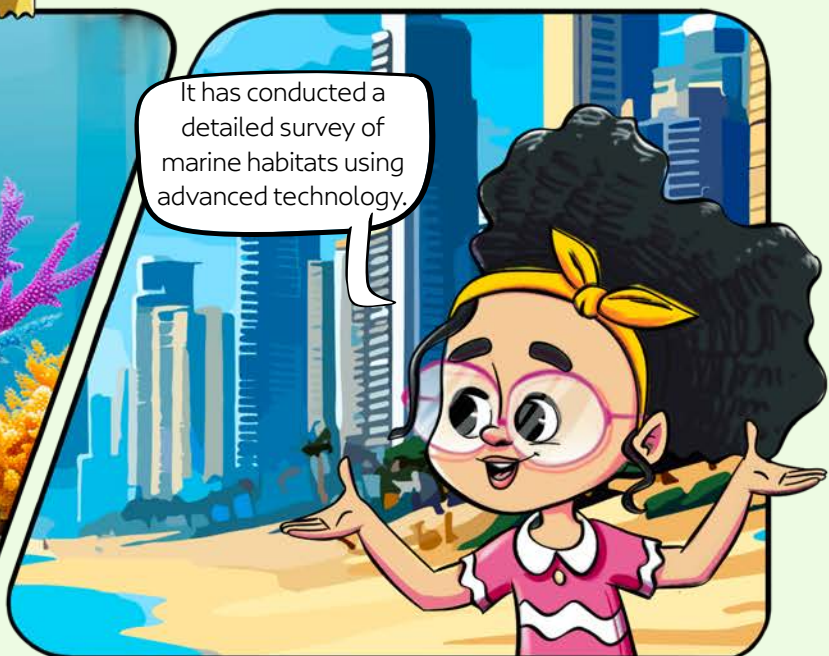


Abu Dhabi has the biggest coral rehabilitation project in the region.

The project planted 312,000 coral pieces in 4 different places, covering 71.8 hectares!



The UAE is also using artificial intelligence to protect coral reefs



It has conducted a detailed survey of marine habitats using advanced technology.
