### Awareness Workshops for Summer Camp Students

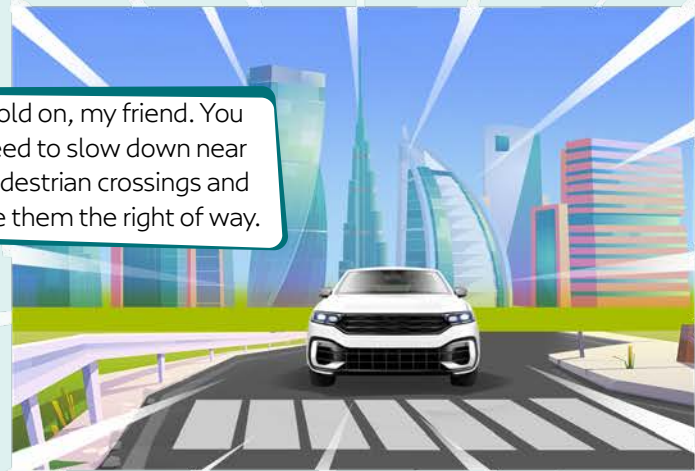
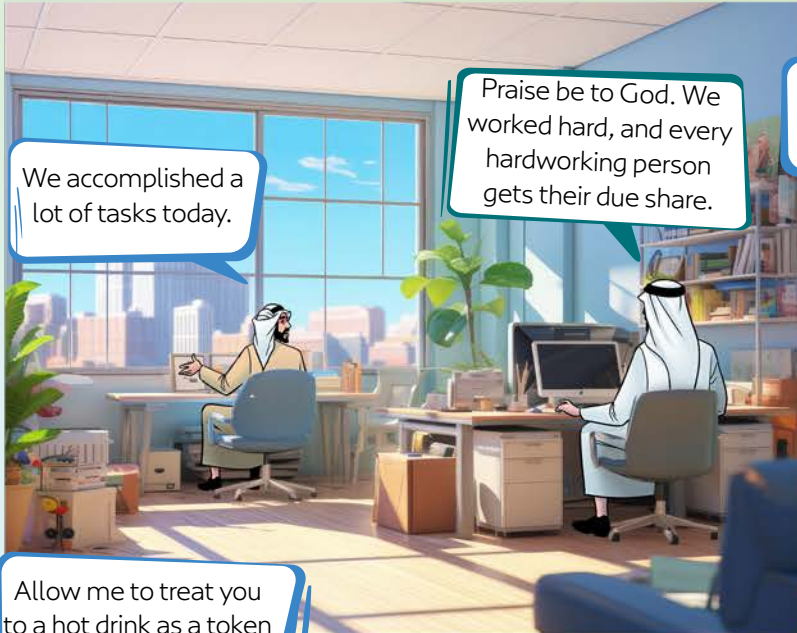




# Respecting Pedestrian Rights

Even without fines, it is crucial to prioritize pedestrian rights and safety.

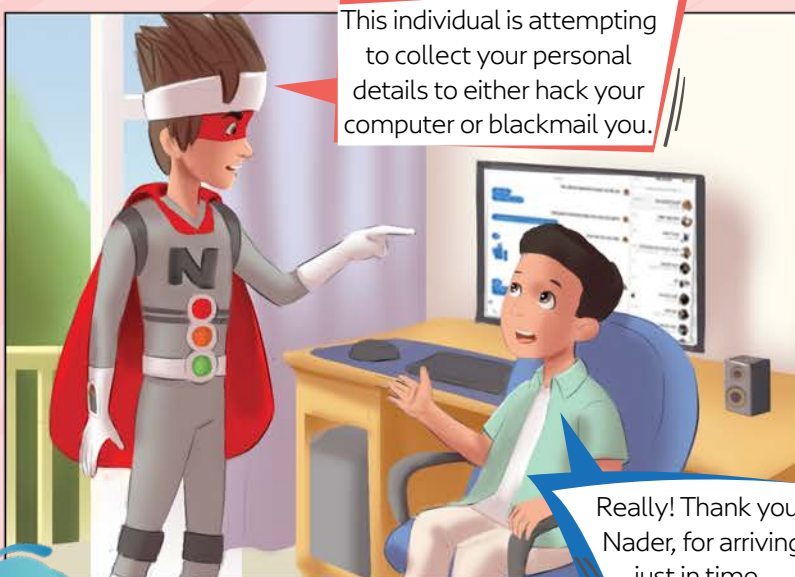

Plus, interactive workshops featuring arts and crafts activities.



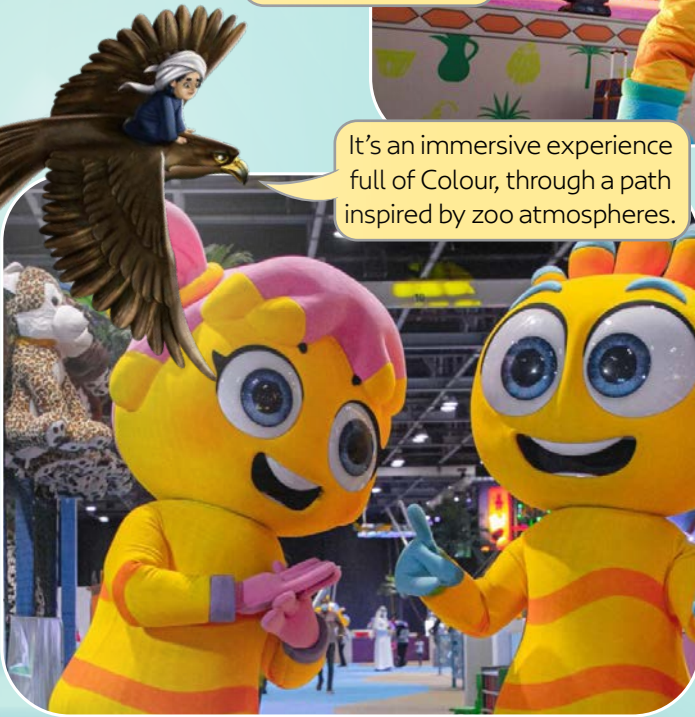


And skill games like kick the bucket, ring toss, tic-tac-toe, and many more.

# Learn Vehicle Safety Tips (2)

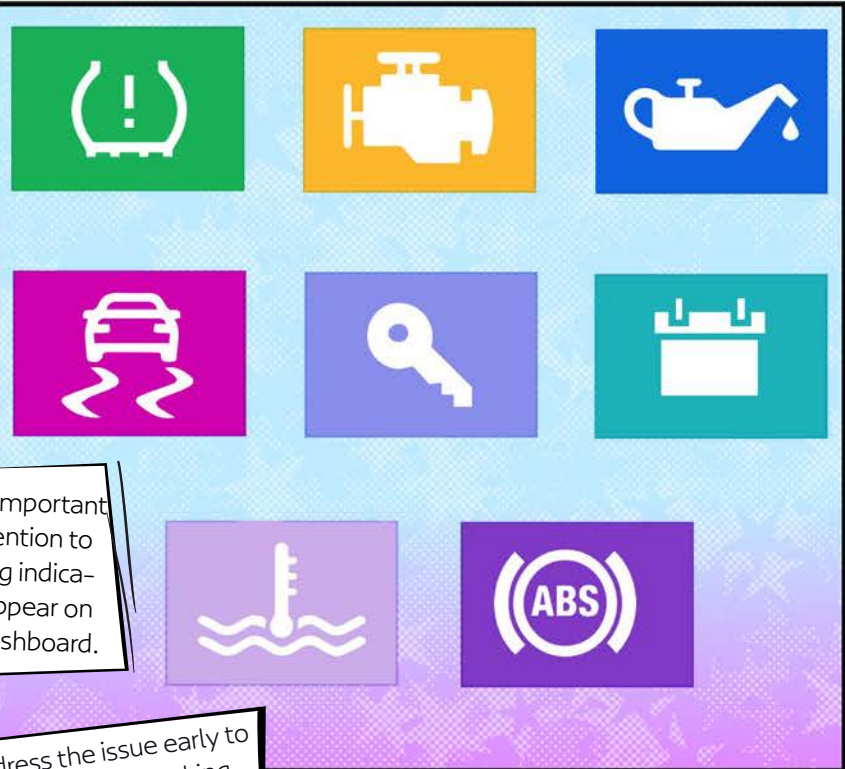

It's always important to pay attention to the warning indicators that appear on the car's dashboard.



Please address the issue early to prevent the car from breaking down and stopping abruptly.



What should I do if that happens, my friend?



Move the vehicle to the far right, stop in a safe place, and turn off the ignition switch.

Call 999 if the vehicle breaks down in the middle of the highway and report your location immediately.

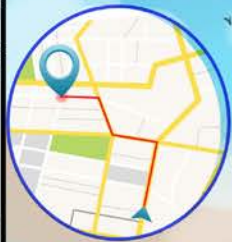

If the vehicle breaks down on the roads sides and does not pose a danger to road users, call 901.

Place the red triangle 100 meters behind the vehicle.



Never leave the vehicle. Wait for the police patrol inside the vehicle or beside it.



Always ensure that the safety equipment in the vehicle is in working condition and a reflective vest is available for use at night.

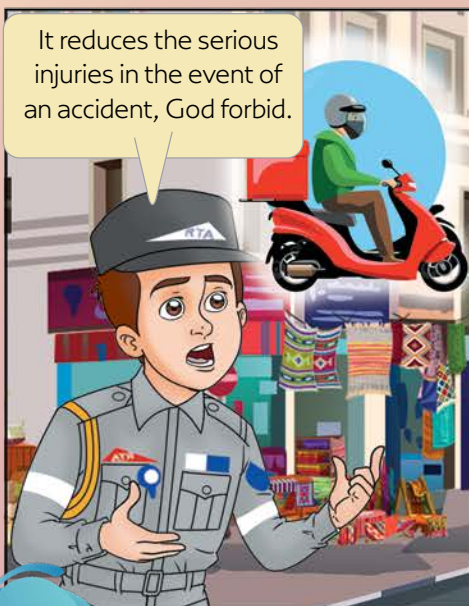

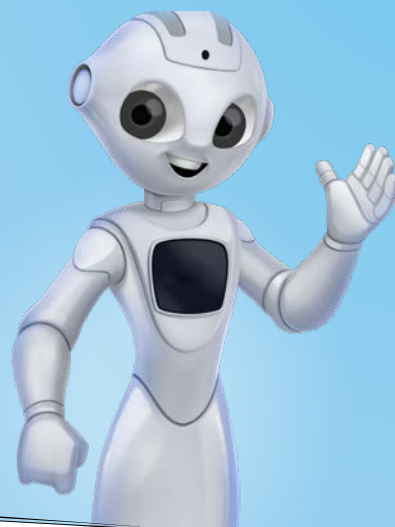


# Enhanced Functionality in the S'hail App

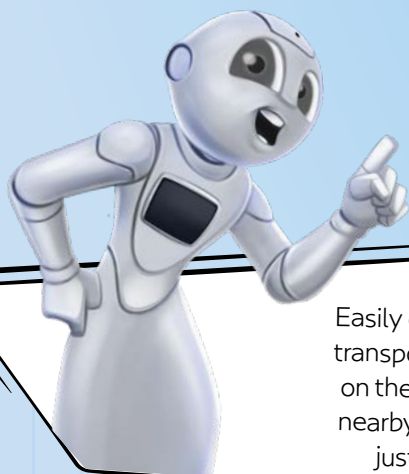

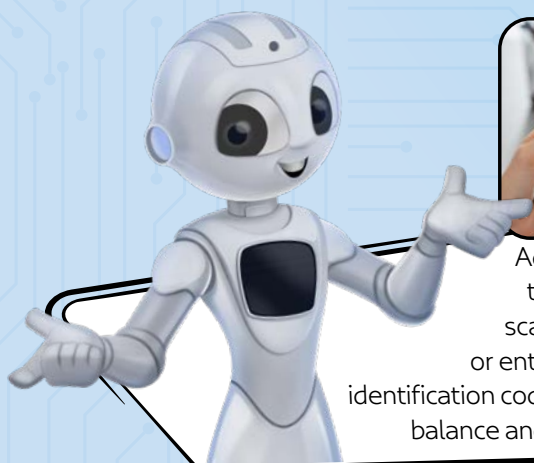
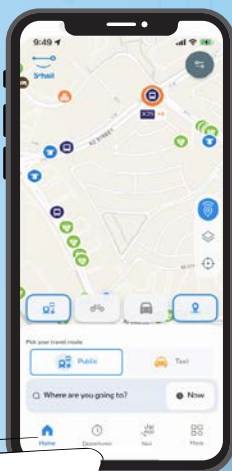
Dubai's Roads and Transport Authority has upgraded the S'hail app, enhancing the user interface with additional features for a smoother experience.

Add a Nol card to your list by scanning the NFC or entering the card identification code to check its balance and refill it.



By scanning the QR code at the bus station, you can access a list of departure times and track trips in real time using the station or area name.



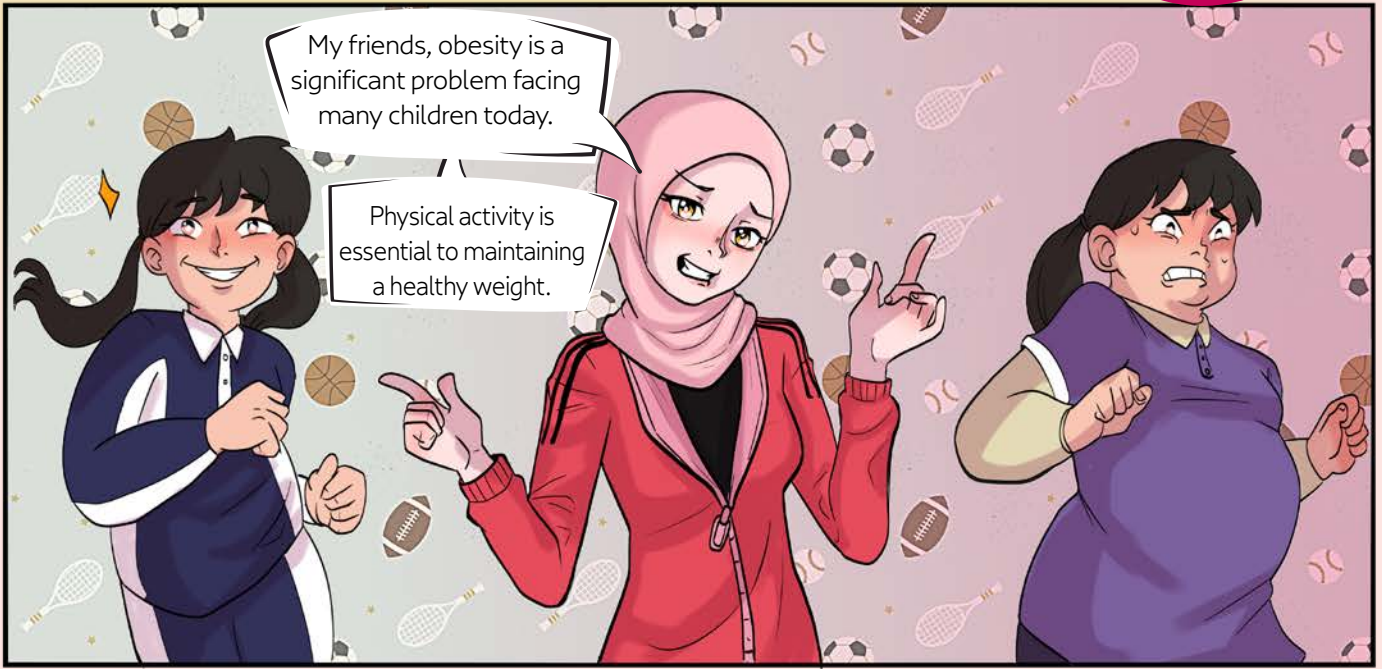

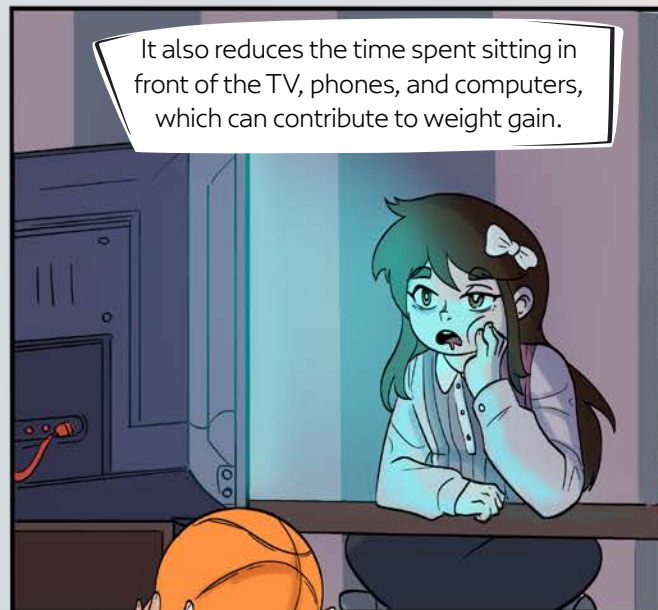

It strengthens our bones, improves flexibility and balance, and boosts our mood and energy levels.



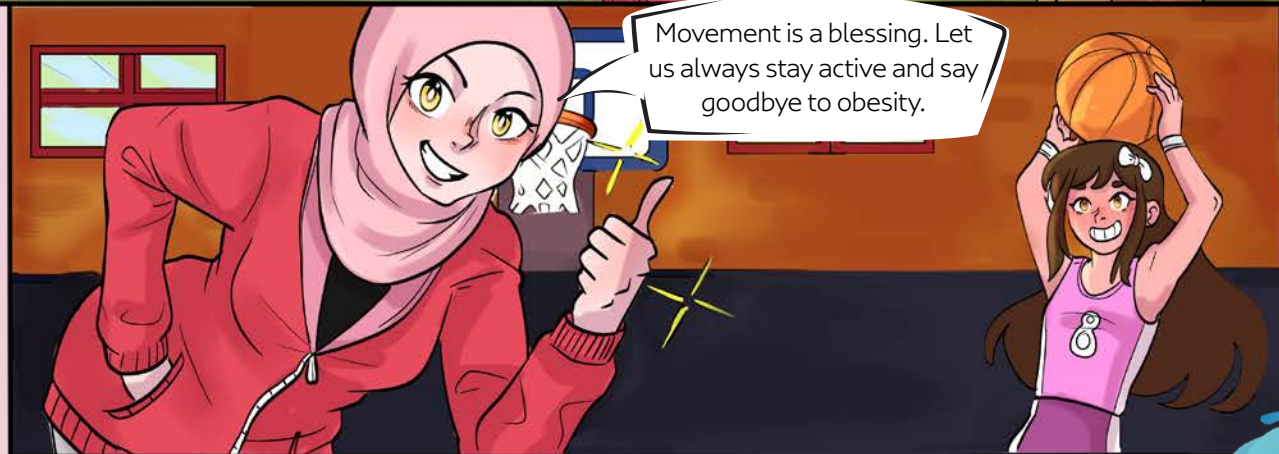
It also reduces the time spent sitting in front of the TV, phones, and computers, which can contribute to weight gain.

Movement is a blessing. Let us always stay active and say goodbye to obesity.

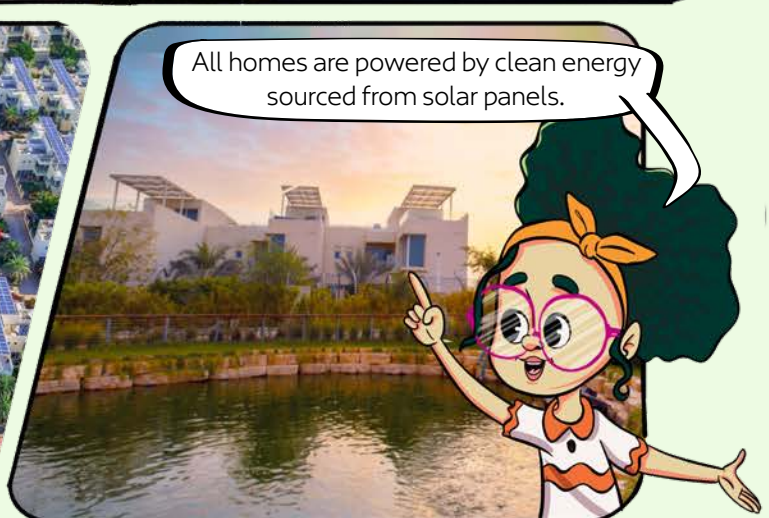
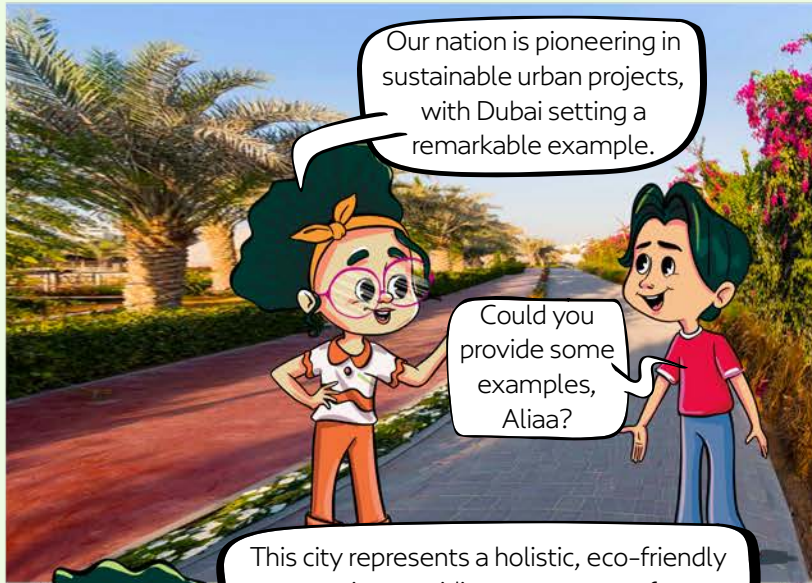

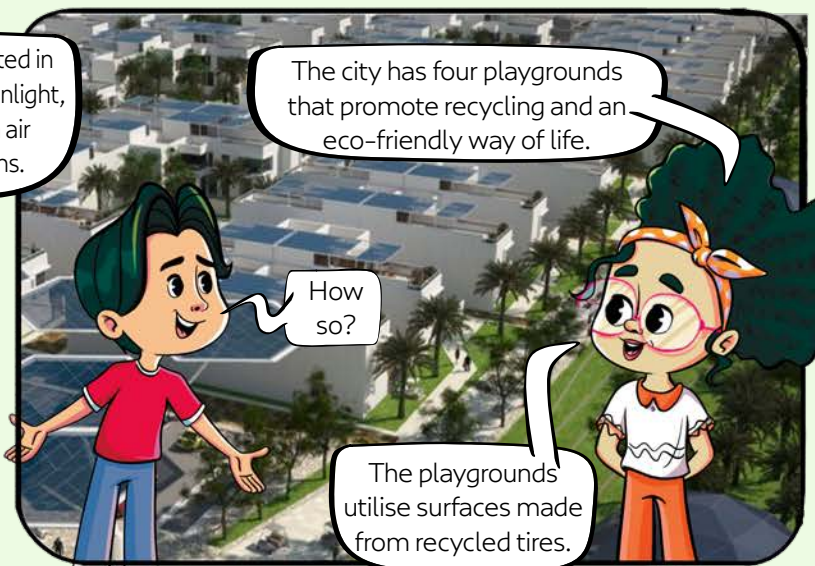
The Eco-friendly

The city has four playgrounds that promote recycling and an eco-friendly way of life.

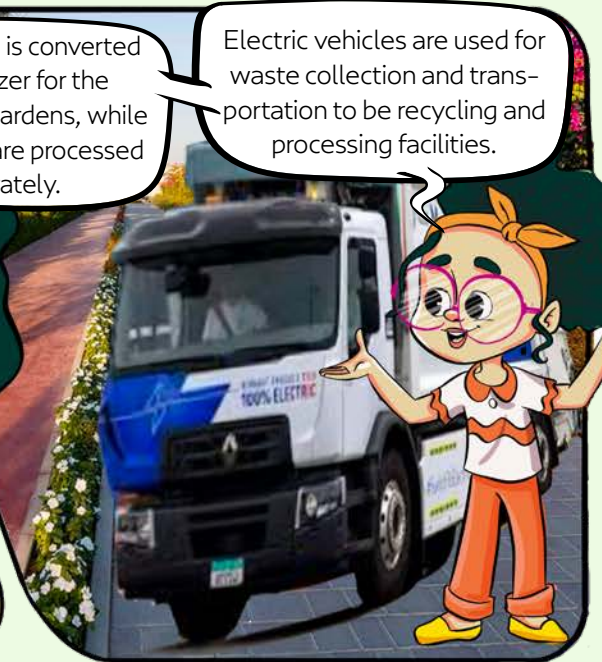
How so?
