Conditions and Procedures of Issuing the Permit	 The applicant shall: be a national of the country, and shall be of good conduct. Pay the prescribed fees. Submit a bank guarantee in the name of RTA, issued by one of the banks operating in the Emirates, in which purposes, value and any other conditions relating thereto shall be specified in accordance with the decisions issued by RTA in this regard. The permit shall be issued according to the following procedures: The permit applicant who wishes to practice the activity shall submit an application for obtaining a commercial license to the competent commercial licensing authority in the Emirate in accordance with the legislation and procedures followed in this regard. The competent commercial licensing authority shall refer the application to the Agency for study and shall ensure that it meets the stipulated conditions and requirements. The Agency shall issue an initial approval for the application to practice the activity after studying it and ensuring that it fulfills the conditions and requirements, within (30) thirty days from the date of submitting the application. The Agency shall provide the competent commercial licensing authority with such approval to complete the procedures for issuing the commercial license. The permit applicant may not practice the activity after the initial approval has been granted and before the permit is issued. In the event that the application does not meet the conditions and requirements approved by the Agency, the competent commercial licensing authority shall be notified of the rejection of the application. The initial approval shall be considered null and void after (60) sixty days of its issuance in the event that the permit applicant does not complete the procedures for issuing the commercial license. 	The application for obtaining a permit for the center shall be submitted to the Agency on the form prepared there accompanied by the required documents:		
	A. A copy of the valid passport and a copy of the valid identity card of the owner.		
	B. A certificate of good conduct issued by the competent authorities in the country and addressed to RTA.		
	C. A written undertaking to comply with the conditions and requirements of practicing the activity.		
	D. A copy of the valid trade license.		
	1- Obtain the required permits from the concerned government bodies in the Emirate and fulfill their requirements.		
	2- Undertake to seek the required approval from the Agency in case of any change in the commercial license.		
	3- Carry annual testing and renewing of the vehicle, and comply with the technical testing conditions and standards set

	4- Comply with the times and places where the activity is prohibited, as required by the concerned body.		
and Entity's	5- Fulfill the security and safety stipulations set by the concerned body.		
Obligations	6- Comply with the additional requirements that may be issued by the Agency in the future.		
	7- Notify the Agency if the applicant wishes to stop practicing the activity before ninety (90) days from the date specified		
	for stopping.		
	8- Comply with the regulations, resolutions and instructions of the RTA.		
	9- Cooperate with RTA officials and those authorized by the RTA, and supply the Agency with the required information		
	and documents.
