Conditions and Procedures of Issuing Permit	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The applicant for the permit must be a citizen of the state, or a citizen of the countries of the Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf, or a legal person who is one of the partners in it from the citizens of the state. 2. For free zones, a legal person or partners' data (non-citizen citizens) in addition to the director's data, based on the free zones' requirements. 3. The permit applicant or his legal representative submits the application to the licensing institution through the service delivery channels approved by the authority accompanied by the following documents: - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A- The initial approval to conduct the activity issued by the commercial licensing authorities in the emirate for new establishments, and a copy of the commercial license for existing establishments. (If any) B- A copy of the valid passport of the owner and all partners, in addition to a copy of the valid residency voucher for the non-citizen partner. C- A copy of the identity card of the owner and all partners. E- An undertaking to abide by the conditions and requirements necessary to carry out the activity. 		
Licensing Conditions and Entity's Obligations	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- Obtaining the necessary licenses and permits from other competent authorities in the Emirate and fulfilling their requirements. 2- Obtaining a permit for the approved tracks and corridors from the competent departments in the Authority and the concerned authorities. 3- Obtaining a driver's permit to drive vehicles according to the procedures approved by the Authority. 4- The establishment's obligation, in the event of any change to the commercial license, to obtain the necessary approval from the establishment. 5- Obtaining the approval of the Authority regarding the type of vehicles and vehicles used in the activity of transporting goods within the specified markets and areas. 		

- 6- Using the vehicles for the authorized purposes only and committing to the activity specified in the permit.
- 7- Provide the security and safety requirements determined by the competent authority.
- 8- Not to stick or hang any advertising materials on the vehicle's chassis without obtaining the Agency's prior approval for that.
- 9- Notify the institution in the event of its desire to temporarily stop the activity from (60) sixty days before the date specified for the cessation and submit the request to stop practicing the activity (30) thirty days before the date specified for the cessation, provided that the period of cessation does not exceed one year. This period may be extended for other periods upon the approval of the Institution.
- 10- Using the parking lots and places approved by the Authority and the competent authorities in the Emirate when carrying out the activity.
- 11- Cooperating with the authority's employees and those authorized by it, and providing the institution with the information, data and documents it requests.
- 12- Comply with the additional requirements that may be issued by the Corporation in the future.
- 13- Comply with the regulations, decisions, and instructions issued by the Authority.
