<b>Conditions and Procedures of Issuing Permit</b>	<p>a) The applicant for the permit must be a citizen of the state, or a citizen of the countries of the Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf, or a legal person who is one of the partners in it from the citizens of the state.</p> <p>b) For free zones, a legal person or partners' data (non-citizen citizens) in addition to the director's data, based on the free zones' requirements.</p> <p>c) 3- The permit applicant or his legal representative submits the application to the licensing institution through the service delivery channels approved by the authority accompanied by the following documents: -</p> <p>A- The initial approval to conduct the activity issued by the commercial licensing authorities in the emirate for new establishments, and a copy of the commercial license for existing establishments. (If any)</p> <p>B- A copy of the valid passport of the owner and all partners, in addition to a copy of the valid residency voucher for the non-citizen partner.</p> <p>C- A copy of the identity card of the owner and all partners.</p> <p>E- An undertaking to abide by the conditions and requirements necessary to carry out the activity.</p>		
<b>Licensing Conditions and Entity's Obligations</b>	<p>1- If the motorbike is used, the manufacturing date must be the same as the year of the registration request.</p> <p>2- Provide a shockproof motorbike helmet in multiple sizes and refrain from renting the motorbike without the protective helmet.</p> <p>3- Refrain from renting a motorbike for anyone who does not hold a motorcycle license.</p> <p>4- Not to rent the bike for use in the delivery operations, except to the companies authorized to it.</p> <p>5- Provide consent approved from concerned bodies according to the nature of the activity.</p> <p>6- Provide a motorbike that suits the type of activity.</p> <p>7- Make comprehensive motorbike insurance with a licensed insurance company in the country.</p> <p>8- Undertake to seek the required approval from the Agency in case of any change in the commercial license.</p> <p>9- Use the motorbike for authorised use only.</p> <p>10- Comply with the security and safety stipulations set by the concerned body.</p> <p>11- Comply with the additional conditions that might be introduced by the Agency in future.</p> <p>12- Notify the Agency about the intention to cease business temporarily 60 days in advance and submit the</p>		

application to cease business 30 days in advance of the set date, provided that the suspension of business must not exceed one year, which is renewable subject to the approval of the Agency.

13- Use the parking spaces approved by RTA and concerned bodies in the Emirate when practising the activity, if any.

14- Cooperate with RTA officials and those authorised by RTA and supply the Agency with the required information and documents.

15- Comply with the regulations, resolutions and instructions of RTA.
