| Conditions and Procedures of Issuing Permit | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The applicant must be Emirati, GCC national, or a corporate body in which an Emirati is a partner 2. The applicant, or legal attorney, submits an application to the Licensing Agency through the official service portals supported with the following documents: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Initial approval issued by the commercial licensing body in the Emirate for new entities, and copy of the commercial license for existing entities b) Approval of the concerned body for practicing the activity, if the applicable legislations require such an approval c) Copy of a valid passport of the owner and all partners along with a copy of a valid residence of a non-Emirati partner d) Copy of the Identity Card of the owner and all partners e) Written undertaking to comply with the conditions and requirements of practicing the activity | | |
| Licensing Conditions and Entity's Obligations | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- If the motorbike is used, the manufacturing date must be the same as the year of the registration request. 2- Provide a shockproof motorbike helmet in multiple sizes and refrain from renting the motorbike without the protective helmet. 3- Refrain from renting a motorbike for anyone who does not hold a motorcycle license. 4- Refrain from renting a motorbike to be used for delivery purposes. 5- Provide consent approved from concerned bodies according to the nature of the activity. 6- Provide a motorbike that suits the type of activity. 7- Make comprehensive motorbike insurance with a licensed insurance company in the country. 8- Undertake to seek the required approval from the Agency in case of any change in the commercial license. 9- Use the motorbike for authorised use only. 10- Comply with the security and safety stipulations set by the concerned body. 11- Comply with the additional conditions that might be introduced by the Agency in future. 12- Notify the Agency about the intention to cease business temporarily 60 days in advance and submit the application to cease business 30 days in advance of the set date, provided that the suspension of business | | |

must not exceed one year, which is renewable subject to the approval of the Agency.

13- Use the parking spaces approved by RTA and concerned bodies in the Emirate when practising the activity, if any.

14- Cooperate with RTA officials and those authorised by RTA and supply the Agency with the required information and documents.

15 - Comply with the regulations, resolutions and instructions of RTA.
