| <b>Activity Description</b>                             | Entities that monitor the movement of heavy trucks on roads to ensure road and pedestrian safety, including the scanning of the road from the starting point to the place of arrival and obtaining licenses from the concerned bodies in coordination with the Dubai Police to ensure the road safety. They ensure that the cargo is placed on the truck correctly, and escort the trucks with cars equipped with cautionary signs.   |                             |                                       |

| <b>Conditions and Procedures of Issuing Permit</b>      | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The applicant for the permit must be a citizen of the state, or a citizen of the countries of the Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf, or a legal person who is one of the partners in it from the citizens of the state.</li> <li>2. For free zones, a legal person or partners' data (non-citizen citizens) in addition to the director's data, based on the free zones' requirements.</li> <li>3. 3- The permit applicant or his legal representative submits the application to the licensing institution through the service delivery channels approved by the authority accompanied by the following documents: - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A- The initial approval to conduct the activity issued by the commercial licensing authorities in the emirate for new establishments, and a copy of the commercial license for existing establishments. (If any)</li> <li>B- A copy of the valid passport of the owner and all partners, in addition to a copy of the valid residency voucher for the non-citizen partner.</li> <li>C- A copy of the identity card of the owner and all partners.</li> <li>E- An undertaking to abide by the conditions and requirements necessary to carry out the activity.</li> </ul> </li> </ol> |                             |                                       |
| <b>Licensing Conditions and Entity's Obligations</b>    | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1- Obtain the required permits from the concerned government bodies in the Emirate and fulfil the requirements.</li> <li>2- Undertake to seek the required approval from the Agency in case of any change in the commercial license.</li> <li>3- Comply with the times and places where the activity is prohibited, as required by the concerned body.</li> <li>4- Comply with the security and safety stipulations set by the concerned body.</li> <li>5- Comply with the additional conditions that might be introduced by the Agency in future.</li> <li>6- Deploy protection or an emergency vehicle that travel behind the truck as specified by the Agency in this regard</li> <li>7- Notify the Agency about the intention to cease business temporarily 60 days in advance and submit the application to cease business 30 days in advance of the set date, provided that the suspension of business must not exceed one year, which is renewable subject to the approval of the Agency.</li> <li>8- Cooperate with RTA officials and those authorised by RTA and supply the Agency with the required</li> </ol>   |                             |                                       |

information and documents.

9- Train drivers to follow security and safety standards when driving and maintain training records.

10- Maintain a database recording the number and category of vehicles, empty and cargo weights, date of the last test, and copy of authorised driver license and vehicle registration. Entities also have to prepare plans for monitoring and responsibilities (vehicle usage, schedule of drivers, accidents and reports records, accidents reporting procedures for drivers, clearance of vehicles broken on roads, and communication with drivers).

11- Issue knowledge certificates to drivers as regards road safety and security during the first year

12 - Comply with the regulations, resolutions and instructions of RTA.
