Activity Description	Establishments whose activity is based on reselling all types of fuels used for vehicles by distributing fuel through a network of stations. This activity also includes establishments that distribute, sell, deliver and supply vehicles with fuel at all places authorized by the competent authorities. The vehicles can be self-driving or semi-autonomous, or any other vehicle type to be developed in the future.

Conditions and Procedures of Issuing the Permit	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To issue the permit, the applicant shall obtain the initial approval of the licensing authority in the Emirate 2. The owner of the establishment, or his legal representative, submits the permit application prepared by the RTA through its approved service delivery channels, accompanied by the following documents: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A. The initial approval to conduct the activity issued by the licensing authority in the Emirate for new establishments, and a copy of the commercial license for existing establishments. B. The approval of the competent authority to carry out the activity if the legislation in force requires obtaining such approval. C. A copy of the valid passport or identity card of the establishment's owner and all partners, in addition to a copy of the valid residency voucher for the non-citizen partner. D. An undertaking to abide by the conditions and requirements necessary to carry out the activity. 		
Responsibilities of the Entity	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Comply with the regulations, resolutions and instructions of the RTA regarding the activity. 2. Provide an office, vehicles and parking spaces commensurate with the nature of the activity authorized to be practiced, and comply with the controls and standards approved by the Agency in this regard. 3. Carry out the activity specified in the permit. 4. The vehicle designated to carry out the authorized activity shall be registered in the Emirate of Dubai, whether it is owned or leased by the establishment. 5. Write the name of the facility, and the weight of the vehicle in its empty and loaded condition in a clear and legible way on the external structure of the vehicle, as approved by the Agency in this regard. 6. Refrain from pasting or carrying any promotional material on the body of the vehicle before obtaining prior approval from the RTA. 7. Not to assign the permit to a third party or dispose of it in any way, except after obtaining the prior approval of the Agency. 8. Use the parking spaces approved by the RTA and concerned bodies in the Emirate when practicing the activity. 9. Cooperate with RTA officials and those authorized by the RTA, and provide the Agency with the required information and documents. 10. Install a tracking system, a speed limit system, or other systems specified by RTA or the concerned entity, as per the nature of the activity 11. Comply with the technical requirements of the vehicle, approved by the Agency and the competent government authorities, according to the activity authorized to be practiced. 12. Obtain licenses and permits required by the legislation in force in the Emirate. 13. The vehicles in which the activity is carried out shall be inspected when licensing or renewing its license at the service centers specified by the Agency in this regard. 14. Not to stop practicing the activity without obtaining the prior approval of the Agency. This approval shall be issued in accordance with the conditions and procedures adopted by the Agency in this regard. 		

15. Keep records that include all data related to the practice of the activity for the periods specified by the Agency in this regard.
16. Comply with the times and places when and where the practice of the activity is prohibited as determined by the competent authority in this regard.
17. Obtain the approval of the Agency in case of changing the location of the establishment.
18. Adhere to the terms and conditions of the approved technical examination determined by the Agency.
19. Not to load any passenger in the vehicle designated for carrying out the activity other than those working in the facility.
20. Not to rent the vehicle designated for carrying out the activity to third parties.
21. Use the vehicle for authorized use only.
22. Fulfill the security and safety stipulations set by the concerned body.
23. Provide vehicles with the years of manufacture and specifications determined by the Agency and competent authority, as the case may be.
24. Provide protection or emergency vehicle to escort the vehicle used in practicing the activity, as stated by the Agency in this regard.
25. Place a distinctive sign on the sides and back of the vehicle indicating that its contents are flammable and explosive materials, according to international standards for labels related to hazardous materials.
26. Equip the vehicle with a tank that can be closed so as to prevent any leaks from the transported materials.
27. Not to fill in all types of fuel at the companies' premises or in public places or truck stops without the approval of the competent authority.
28. Fulfill the requirements of the establishment that houses tankers of petroleum products, which are imposed by the competent authority.
29. Fulfill the requirements of the committee for the circulation of petroleum materials at the Emirate level.
30. Agree to undertake to comply with the additional requirements set by the Agency.
