<b>Activity Description</b>	Entities that transport explosive and hazardous materials on vehicles intended for the same purpose with specifications conforming to the requirements of the licensing and concerned bodies in the emirate. Such vehicles can be fully or semi-autonomous, or any other type that may be introduced in the future for this purpose.

<b>Conditions and Procedures of Issuing Permit</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The applicant must be Emirati, GCC national, or a corporate body in which an Emirati is a partner</li> <li>2. The applicant, or legal attorney, submits an application to the Licensing Agency through the official service portals supported with the following documents: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Initial approval issued by the commercial licensing body in the Emirate for new entities, and copy of the commercial license for existing entities</li> <li>b) Approval of the concerned body for practicing the activity, if the applicable legislations require such an approval</li> <li>c) Copy of a valid passport of the owner and all partners along with a copy of a valid residence of a non-Emirati partner</li> <li>d) Copy of the Identity Card of the owner and all partners</li> <li>e) Written undertaking to comply with the conditions and requirements of practicing the activity</li> </ol> </li> </ol>		
<b>Licensing Conditions and Entity's Obligations</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1- Obtain the required permits from the concerned government bodies in the Emirate and fulfil the requirements.</li> <li>2- Undertake to seek the required approval from the Agency in case of any change in the commercial license.</li> <li>3- Provide vehicles with specifications befitting the activity as decided by the Agency or the concerned entities in this regard.</li> <li>4- Carry annual testing and renewing of the vehicle and comply with the technical testing conditions and standards set by the Agency.</li> <li>5- Comply with the times and places where the activity is prohibited, as stated by the Agency.</li> <li>6- Refrain from lifting riders other than workers of the entity.</li> <li>7- Refrain from renting owned or affiliated vehicles to third parties.</li> <li>8- Use vehicles for authorised use only and compliance with the activity stated in the permit.</li> </ol>		

- 9- Comply with the security and safety stipulations set by the concerned body.
- 10- Comply with the additional conditions that might be introduced by the Agency in future.
- 11- Refrain from pasting or carrying any promotional material on the body of the vehicle before obtaining prior approval from the Agency.
- 12- Notify the Agency about the intention to cease business temporarily 60 days in advance and submit the application to cease business 30 days in advance of the set date, provided that the suspension of business must not exceed one year, which is renewable subject to the approval of the Agency.
- 13- Use the parking spaces approved by RTA and concerned bodies in the Emirate when practicing the activity, if any.
- 14- Cooperate with RTA officials and those authorised by RTA and supply the Agency with the required information and documents.
- 15- Place distinctive marks on both sides and rear of the vehicle indicating that it has an inflammable and explosive content, according to the international standards for labelling hazardous materials.
- 16- Refrain from parking in public parking or causing any negative effects on public parking.
- 17- Comply with the regulations, resolutions and instructions of RTA.
